INITIATIVES

The employment unit engaged in the following broad outreach initiatives in accordance with various elements of FCC Rule 73.2080(c)(2):

*Participated in **job fairs** by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in making hiring decisions.*

The Station Manager and Membership Director participated in MSU Career Fairs at Curris Center on 10/10/17 and 3/06/2018, soliciting resumes and explaining part-time position availability.

*Established an **internship** program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.*

WKMS has an ongoing paid intern program for MSU Students, working up to 20 hours a week. Some are trained to produce news meeting NPR standards. Others work in operations, promotions or administrative capacities with WKMS staff. WKMS also intakes volunteer producers who are trained as on-air presenters.
