

**PROGRAM/ISSUES REPORT NOTIFICATION**

**Third Quarter 2016**

I, Jennifer Waldherr, as Coordinator, Broadcast and Traffic Operations of WIWN (TV) DTV Channel 68.1, 68.2, 68.3, 68.4, 68.5, 68.6, 68.7, and 68.8, Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, hereby certify that for the period of June 1, 2016 to September 30, 2016, WIWN (TV) aired local programming addressing community issues and concerns. Among those addressed were:

**1. Streetcar System, Starchase System in Police Cars, Milwaukee Bucks Arena, Practice Facility and Parking Garage ("Council Rewind")**

This program features issues before the Milwaukee Common Council from May 10, 2016 to May 24, 2016. Segment topics include plans to expand the streetcar system, a report on the deployment of the Starchase system in police squad cars, and details on plans for the new Buck's Arena, practice facility and parking garage.

**2. City Crime; New State Law Regarding Building Codes; Work Schedules/Rules For City Employees ("Council Rewind")**

This program features issues before the Milwaukee Common Council from May 31, 2016 to June 14, 2016. Topics include a discussion with Police Chief Flynn about crime in the city, how the City will adjust to a new state law which restricts or prohibits some building code enforcement programs, and how the city will study alternative work schedules and rules for city workers.

**3. Street Car System Extension; City Criminal Justice System; City Water System ("Council Rewind")**

This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council from 6/20/2016 to 7/06/2016. Topics include an extension to the streetcar system, issues with replacing lead pipe service lines in the water system, and a discussion with court representatives about the criminal justice system in Milwaukee.


**4. Bus Rapid Transit Route Approval; High Rise Apartment Building Debate; Commissioner of City Development Appointment**

This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between July 11, 2016 and July 26, 2016. Topics include approval of a bus rapid transit route, debate on a high rise apartment building on Prospect Avenue, and the second round in the appointment of the Commissioner of City Development.

**5. Adoption From Foster Care: "Hair Cut" (Public Service Announcement, AD Council, PSA Central)**

Shows the bond that can happen between a Foster Mother and her adopted Son while she's cutting his hair.
