Among those addressed were:

- Fire and Police Commission, Tavern Licensing, Feral Cats ("Council Rewind")
 This program highlights issues from the Common Council cycle meetings held between 3/16/15 and 3/31/15. Topics include an appointment to the Fire & Police Commission, a license hearing for the Villard Inn and creating a new program for dealing with feral cats in the city.
- Preparing for a Train Disaster, Rideshare Services, Rent-to-Own ("Council Rewind")
 This program focuses on issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between April 6,
 2015 and April 212, 2015. Topics include a discussion on preparedness for a train disaster,
 the effect of new state legislation regulating rideshare services and an update on the City's
 Rent-to-Own program.
- Rail Safety in the City, Spring Crime Statistics, Peace Project ("Council Rewind")
 This program is about issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between April 28, 2015 and May 12, 2015. Topics include questions about rail safety through the city, spring crime statistics and the Milwaukee Peace Project.
- 4. Promoting gratitude ("Respect-Foundation for a Better Life PSA", "Teacher Reading PSA")
 Part of living in a community is about respecting each other and helping one another out.
 Public Service Announcements between local programming show a gentleman stranded without change to call from a payphone for help, but is given money from two women who see him struggling. He thanks them. Another Public Service Announcement shows a teacher helping a young student struggling, and the gratitude from the student and the student's mother when she begins to flourish.
