Among those addressed were:

- The Progress of the "Complete Milwaukee Program", Bus Safety ("Council Rewind")
 This program features topics and issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between
 February 15, 2016 and March 1, 2016. Topics include the progress of the Compete
 Milwaukee program, bus safety in the city and new revenue as part of the Milwaukee Civic
 Partnership Initiative.
- 2. City Compliance of School Properties Surplus Sale, Collection of Outstanding Debts, Local Business Action Team Report ("Council Rewind")

 This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council from March 14, 2016 to March 29, 2016. Topics of the segments are 1) How the city can comply with a state law requiring the sale of surplus school properties, 2) creating a task force to find ways for the City to collect oustanding debts, and 3) a report on the Local Business Action Team, which is working to make city processes more business friendly.
- 3. Milwaukee Buck "Live Block", TID to Restore Germania Building, Partnership for Studying Heroin and Opiates Epidemic in The City ("Council Rewind")

 This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council during the cycle from 04/06/16 to 04/15/16. Topics include a lease for N. 4th Street for the Buck's "Live Block", creating a TID to restore the Germania Building and a new partnership to study the heroin and opioid epidemic in our area.
- 4. Streetcar System, Starchase System in Police Cars, Milwaukee Bucks Arena, Practice Facility and Parking Garage ("Council Rewind")
 This program features issues before the Milwaukee Common Council from May 10, 2016 to May 24, 2016. Segment topics include plans to expand the streetcar system, a report on the deployment of the Starchase system in police squad cars, and details on plans for the new Buck's Arena, practice facility and parking garage.
- 5. Bullying: Glasses (Public Service Announcement, Ad Council, PSA Central) A young girl with glasses talks about her experiences of being bullied, and the very surprising responses she received when her Mom put her story on Facebook.
