I, Jennifer Waldherr, as Coordinator, Broadcast and Traffic Operations of WIWN (TV) DTV Channel 68.1, 68.2, 68.3, 68.4, 68.5, 68.6, 68.7, and 68.8, Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, hereby certify that for the period of October 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016, WIWN (TV) aired local programming addressing community issues and concerns.

Among those addressed were:

1. Bus Rapid Transit Route; Apartment Building on Prospect Avenue

This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between July 11, 2016 and July 26, 2016. Topics include approval of a bus rapid transit route, debate on a high-rise apartment building on Prospect Avenue, and the second round in the appointment of the Commissioner of City Development.

2. In-person Absentee Voting; Creating an African-American Affairs Government Office

This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between September 1, 2016 and September 20, 2016. Topics include changes to in-person absentee voting for November's election, creation of an Office of African-American Affairs in city government, and a proposal to build new housing at an old factory on North Avenue.

3. "Ban the Box" on Job Applications; Building a New Clinic in Bucks Arena

This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between Sept. 27, 2016 and October 11, 2016. Topics include a resolution to "ban the box" on job applications, building a new clinic in the Bucks Arena development and taking testimony on public safety issues before the Public Safety Committee.


4. New Municipal ID Program; Banning Smokeless Tobacco Products from Sports Facilities

This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between November 7, 2016 and November 22, 2016. Topics include creating a new municipal ID program, banning smokeless tobacco products from sports facilities and creating a program to replace water laterals that have lead pipes.
