I, Jennifer Waldherr, as Coordinator, Broadcast and Traffic Operations of WIWN (TV) DTV Channel 68.1, 68.2, and 68.3 Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, hereby certify that for the period of July 1, 2015 to September 30, 2015, WIWN (TV) aired local programming addressing community issues and concerns.

Among those addressed were:

- 1. Marijuana Possession, Homes Foreclosure, Johnson Controls Partnership (Council Rewind)
 This program covers topics before the Milwaukee Common Council between May 14, 2015 and
 June 2, 2015. Topics include an ordinance to lower fines for marijuana possession, accelerating
 the foreclosure process on some homes and creating a partnership with Johnson Controls on
 the Gateway Project. We end the program with a farewell to Alderman Joe Dudzik.
- 2. City Chartered Schools, Finance Proposal for Milwaukee Buck's Arena (Council Rewind) This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between June 5, 2015 and June 23, 2015. Topics include a proposal to have a 5-year moratorium on City chartered schools and the public finance proposal for a new Milwaukee Bucks' arena.
- 3. Taxi Cab Colors, Rail Bridges Inspections, Violent Crime In The City (Council Rewind)

 This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between July 7, 2015 and
 July 23, 2015. Topics include: regulating taxi cab colors; inspection of rail bridges and how it is
 done; and a comprehensive review of city department's response to violent crime in the city.
- 4. Promoting gratitude ("Respect-Foundation for a Better Life PSA", "Teacher Reading PSA")

Part of living in a community is about respecting each other and helping one another out. Public Service Announcements between local programming show a gentleman stranded without change to call from a payphone for help, but is given money from two women who see him struggling. He thanks them. Another Public Service Announcement shows a teacher helping a young student struggling, and the gratitude from the student and the student's mother when she begins to flourish.
