

PROGRAM/ISSUES REPORT NOTIFICATION

1st Quarter, January 1st – March 31st 2016

I, Jennifer Waldherr, as Coordinator, Broadcast and Traffic Operations of WIWN (TV) DTV Channel 68.1, 68.2, 68.3, 68.4, 68.5, 68.6, 68.7, and 68.8 Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, hereby certify that for the period of January 1st through March 31st, 2016, WIWN (TV) aired local programming addressing community issues and concerns.

Among those addressed were:

1. Zoning change for Milwaukee Bucks Arena, Ordinance changes the way school bus drivers drop off children ("Council Rewind")

This program highlights issues before the Milwaukee Common Council from Jan. 5, 2016 to Jan. 19, 2016. Topics include zoning changes for the Bucks new arena, an ordinance that requires school bus drivers to change the way they drop off students and a review of the plowing policies during the Dec. 28, 2015 snowstorm.

2. Progress of "Compete Milwaukee" Program; City Bus Safety ("Council Rewind")

Topics before the Milwaukee Common Council between January 25, 2016 and February 9, 2016. Topics include lead levels in water laterals to homes, modifying winter parking restrictions and a Youth Council proposal to create a Restorative Justice program for youths.


3. City Compliance with surplus public school property; City Task Force to deal with outstanding debt ("Council Rewind")

This program features topics and issues before the Milwaukee Common Council between February 15, 2016 and March 1, 2016. Topics include the progress of the Compete Milwaukee program, bus safety in the city and new revenue as part of the Milwaukee Civic Partnership Initiative.

4. Promoting gratitude ("Respect-Foundation for a Better Life PSA", "Teacher Reading PSA")

Part of living in a community is about respecting each other and helping one another out. Public Service Announcements between local programming show a gentleman stranded without change to call from a payphone for help, but is given money from two women who see him struggling. He thanks them. Another Public Service Announcement shows a teacher helping a young student struggling, and the gratitude from the student and the student's mother when she begins to flourish.
