WWAZ-TV's primary source of programming this quarter was the FamilyNet network. In addition to FamilyNet, we aired a 30-minute locally-produced program once per week. This program, called Community Showcase, has topics which we believe are of local significance. The program is aired Wednesday mornings at 8:30 am, and often contains a number of Public Service Announcements. Community Showcase episodes for this quarter were as follows:

FamilyNet also broadcasts Public Service Announcements, but specific content is not known. In addition, FamilyNet regularly airs a number of informational programs, such as the 700 Club, which airs weekdays at noon, and Christian World News, which airs Mondays at 9:00 a.m. The 700 Club is a one-hour magazine program that includes daily news segments, commentary on a wide range of political and social issues and current events. Christian World News covers a wide range of subjects of concern for

Christians.

WWAZ-TV also airs several children's programs such as:Nana Puddin' ShowFlip Flop ShopView From the ZooBuzz and Poppy

Lil' Iguana Adventures in Odyssey

WWAZ-TV has also begun a Community Calendar feature, which will contain announcements of upcoming events of community interest. Promotional announcements for the Calendar were aired nine times during the quarter.

WWAZ-TV will continue to assess issues of importance to our community and air programming and announcements designed to meet those needs.
