Generally these issues are self-explanatory in nature, for example "crime" and "education." Some issues encompass a number of interrelated sub-issues:

Consumer Issues – an example of this would be consumer recalls on items such as cars, food and baby products that could affect the health and safety of many viewers

Government Issues – An example would be ballot measures that effected the state such as the legalization of marijuana.

Minority Issues – An example would be stories regarding the protests of police brutality towards suspects of color.

Socio-Political Issues – An example would be ballet measures that propose the freedom for same-sex couples to marry.

LOCAL PROGRAMMING

GOOD DAY OREGON AND KPTV NEWS AT 5:00PM, 6:00PM, 10:00PM AND 11:00PM

FOX 12 produces an hour newscast Monday through Sunday at 10:00p.m., a half hour newscast at 11:00p.m. Monday through Friday, and an hour newscast Monday through Friday at 5:00pm and 6:00pm and a four and a half hour morning show Monday through Friday from 4:30am-9:00am and 6:00am - 9:00am on Saturday and 7:00am – 9:00am on Sunday. In all, this provides high quality, informative newscasts to FOX 12's viewing public as well as contributes to the diversity of news sources available in prime time and morning hours.

What follows is a sampling of the types of issues regularly treated in FOX 12 News at 5:00p.m., 6:00p.m., 10:00p.m., and 11:00p.m. as well as Fox 12's morning show, Good Day Oregon.

Many of the following stories ran multiple times throughout different newscasts, although only one instance is noted below within the Local Programming Segment of this report.

Air Date: 1/2/15 10PM News, Running Time: 1:40

HEALTH/FAMILY ISSUES

This story focused on a warning from some hospitals who are limiting visitors who might be dangerous for already vulnerable hospital patients. The restrictions don't keep everyone out, only those who are sick or have been in contact with someone who is sick. This week alone, nine in the area tested positive for the Flu and across the country, it's killed at least fifteen children.

Air Date: 1/5/15 5PM News, Running Time: 2:20

ENVIRONMENT/SAFETY ISSUES

This story focused on a landslide warning after seven inches of rain fell in 24 hours. The threat forced some neighborhoods to evacuate and washed out foundations of three homes. Forecasters say the danger will continue for several days. Our story showed how people were dealing with the flooding. The Department of Transportation scrambled to clear the massive trees and mud that covered at State Route. The sheer force shoved heavy concrete barriers over the ledge, stranding drivers. County officials were likely to declare a local state of emergency.

CRIME/HEALTH ISSUES

This story focused on a new program within the Portland Police Bureau where police officers will now carry potentially life-saving medication that could help someone suffering from a drug overdose. According to the Police bureau, there were 65 heroin drug overdoses in 2013. They believe that if their officers on the street come in contact with someone overdosing, they might be able to save them.

CRIME/SAFETY ISSUES

This story focused on the issue of Portland's street improvement which will be put on the May Ballot. A hearing was held at Portland City Hall in order to discuss the options. There could be as many as six, likely including an increased gas tax, a progressive income tax or a local option property tax levy, although voting no won't be an option. The audience was happy they will have a voice by vote for the final choice.

GOVERNMENT/ECONOMY ISSUES

This story focused on the inauguration ceremony for the Oregon Governor's historic fourth term. In his speech he talked about Oregon's economic recovery being on the up-swing, but said enough good jobs were not being created fast enough and we will need to work together.

CRIME ISSUES

This story focused on information from Portland Police showing Subaru's as the second most stolen car in the city and how theft victims are taking action. Two hundred ninety-eight Subaru's were stolen in 2014. Police say cars are usually stolen because they're either easy to steal or there's a market for their parts. Victims are using social media to help each other keep an eye out for their cars. Police recommend multiple layers of protection to deter car thieves.

MINORITY/ECONOMY ISSUES

This story focused on a new program to help create jobs in the St. Louis Area after all the protests in Ferguson Missouri. The goal is to help men, specifically black men get the job training they need for the workforce. Leaders say unemployment is a huge factor in community issues. They hope to help hundreds in the surrounding area.

HEALTH/ENVIRONMENT/ECONOMY ISSUES

This story segment focused on the future of controversial open-air reservoirs in Portland and the nearly five million dollar plan that could change the way water is delivered. The city council had a first-reading of a plan that would take the open-air reservoirs out of the water supply altogether. In May, more than half a million people were affected by one of the largest boil-water advisories in the history of Portland, after e-coli and total coliform were found in two local reservoirs. Also, a man was caught urinating into the open reservoir, forcing the city to drain 38 million gallons of drinking water. Years ago, the city council adopted a plan to take the open reservoirs offline by December 31st of 2015. The existing reservoir pipes will be disconnected and new ones will be built to reroute the drinking water through the system at a cost of 4.8 million dollars. Commissioners will be asking for public input on the future of the existing reservoirs.

FAMILY/HEALTH ISSUES

This story focused on the widespread problem of influenza in Oregon and most of America. According to the CDC, this year's flu shots may not protect everyone. Only 23% of flu shots have been effective this year. Doctors said this year's virus mutated after the vaccines were produced. As the flu outbreak spreads, visits to hospitals and pharmacies are up, although some hospitals are advising some individuals with flu not to visit the hospital to keep from spreading the virus.

MINORITY ISSUES

This story focused on the life and legacy of Civil Rights Activist Reverend Martin Luther King Jr., who was celebrated around the country on this day. President Obama and the First lady participated in a community service project at a local boys and girls club. The 9th Annual Martin Luther King Jr. Peace walk and Parade took place, although today's events fall in the shadow of a year of escalating racial tensions after the deaths of two unarmed black men. Locally, hundreds of students from 10 different colleges and universities around Portland spent their day off volunteering in the community.

GOVERNMENT/ECONOMY ISSUES

This story focused on President Obama's State of the Union Address where he shared his broad vision for the end of his term. His address covered a wide range of topics from free community college to the war on terror. Many of his proposals are designed to benefit the middle class, some of which he wants to pay for by closing tax breaks for the wealthy. Republicans argue that while these benefits are nice, they all come with a price that the federal government can no longer afford. The president also asked for unity in the fight against global terror, an area where he could find support from Republicans.

ECONOMY/SAFETY/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a Polk County Family that believes their son died because there were no sheriff's deputies on duty when they called 911. Due to budget cuts, there are no Polk County Deputies on duty from 10pm to noon. A family says that wasted minutes that could have saved their son's life as a medic crew was delayed waiting for law enforcement to secure the scene. Polk County Voters have rejected a levy to fund public safety in the past, but the county wants to put another levy on the May Ballot.

CRIME/GOVERNMENT/FAMILY/SAFETY ISSUES

This story focused on a vote by the Portland City Council to support a federal lawsuit against "Back Page Dot Com", a website used by escort services and linked to sex trafficking. January is "National Slavery and Human Trafficking Awareness Month" and we spoke with a survivor of sexual exploitation to talk about the problems here in Portland and how she made it back to a normal life.

MINORITY/SOCIO-POLITICAL/FAMILY/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a local pair of 6-year-old twins who are in the middle of an international custody battle that will likely end with them living in Mexico with their ex-felon father. A judge has decided the twins should live with their dad. These twins were born in Portland. Their mother lost custody of them and their father was deported after getting out of prison. State officials want them with their father, but other relatives feel they'll be in danger and traumatized.

MINORITY/ECONOMY ISSUES

This story focused on a plan approved by the city council to spend 20 million dollars on affordable housing after steep housing prices have forced many African-American families out of North and Northeast Portland. The money will go toward building affordable rental housing on bureau-owned land. It will also create affordable, single-family homes and allow people to get immediate help with loans for first time home buyers.

HEALTH ISSUES

This story focused on the hazards of e-cigarettes. Three states have now issues advisories cautioning their use. The Sate of CA said in a report yesterday that e-cigarettes emit cancer-causing chemicals and get users addicted to nicotine. Officials said they should be strictly regulated like tobacco. E-cigarettes heat liquid nicotine from cartridges into breathable vapor without the tar and other chemicals found in traditional cigarettes.

EDUCATION/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on the graduation rates of Oregon Public High Schools. The 2014 rates were just released at 72% which is up from the rate of 69% in 2013, but a long way from the governor's goal of 100% by 2025. Although there was a gain, it could be because of the new way they are calculating it, now considering special education students with modified diplomas as graduates. Oregon's graduation rate ranks among the lowest in the country.

EDUCATION/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a national debate about the need for recess in schools. With federal and state mandates such as "No Child Left Behind", teachers are under more pressure to make students succeed, which comes at a price. Some school districts across the country are eliminating recess, physical education, art and music all in an effort to get more learning time in the classroom. Teachers say kids are under an enormous amount of pressure to perform well on state tests. And in many districts, teacher's salaries depend on how well their students perform. However, child therapists say recess helps kids develop neurologically and socially and kids need to take a break from their long day of learning.

HEALTH/FAMILY ISSUES

This story focused on a recent outbreak of Measles with 95 reported cases. The outbreak has been linked to Disneyland with the majority of cases in California. The outbreak now causing particular concern is in Arizona where health officials say as many as one thousand people may have been recently exposed to the Measles. Doctors say Measles is one of the most contagious diseases. A person can get it simply by breathing in air shared by an infected person. But despite pleas from the medical community, some parents are still refusing to get their children vaccinated, saying they're worried the Measles vaccine could lead to autism even though a number of leading health organizations, including the CDC, say the vaccine does not cause autism.

SOCIO-POLITICAL/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a statement from the Governor addressing the controversy surrounding his fiancé. During a news conference today, he said she will no longer play a role in his administration, although he still loves her and their wedding is still on. His fiancé came under fire in October when she admitted to entering into a green card marriage for money and allegations surfaced that she was using her position as First Lady and advisor to the governor to get private consulting contracts.

Air Date: 1/31/15 10PM News, Running Time: :55

ENVIRONMENT/EDUCATION ISSUES

This story focused on an event in the East Columbia Neighborhood of Portland where volunteers took part in planting hundreds of trees at the Columbia Children's Arboretum. It's a space owned by Portland Parks and Recreation. It's a project that organizers said is an investment in the neighborhood that will benefit the community for decades to come. Several students from the Rosemary Anderson alternative High School helped lead the event. Organizers said it compliments what they're learning in the classroom and is helping to foster future careers in natural resources.

CONSUMER/SAFETLY ISSUES

This story focused on a massive auto recall. It involved more than two million older model vehicles that could have faulty air bags. There's a problem with the "crash sensors" that can cause the airbags to deploy for no reason. This is the second time vehicles have been recalled for the same problem. Viewers with an Acura MDX, Jeep Grand Cherokee, Honda Odyssey, Pontiac Vibe, or Toyota Corolla, Matrix or Avalon made between 2002 and 2004 were encouraged to call their auto dealer.

SAFETY/FAMILY/CRIME ISSUES

This story focused on a warning to parents after a man tried to lure two young boys into his car on their way to school. Now parents with children at this elementary school are on edge after this incident just blocks from campus. The school sent a letter home to parents and school resource officers are now being vigilant in the area as parents are talking to their kids about staying safe. Police asked for any information from the public.

SAFETY/FAMILY/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a restrictions being considered by the Multnomah County Board of Commissioner and the Board of Health on E-Cigarettes and other vaping devices. The proposed ordinance would make it illegal for anyone under 18 to have one of the devices. Health experts say unregulated products can contain harmful chemicals and the nicotine can hurt teen brain development and could encourage kids to use tobacco in the future.

SOCIO-POLITICAL/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a recall petition filed today saying the Governor embezzled funds and failed to protect Oregon. This comes after months of accusations of unethical and possibly illegal behavior by his fiancé. The petition was filed by “Safer Oregon PAC”. A FOX 12 political analyst said he’s not surprised about the petition, but that it’s going to take some time, especially with what it says in the Oregon Constitution that you can only recall someone who’s in office for six months, although the Governor has been in for more than 12 years.

SOCIO-POLITICAL/GOVERNMENT/HEALTH/ENVIRONMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a possible ban of all tobacco products from all city parks. Right now, smoking is banned in a handful of Portland Parks, but City Council Members are thinking about making all city parks smoke-free by this July. The ban would include e-cigarettes and vaporizers. More than 500 other U.S. cities currently have smoke free parks. Many people welcome the ban, but some think it is unfair since a park is an open area and people should be free to do whatever they like. The City Commissioners will start discussing the park tobacco plan this week.

CRIME/SAFETY/FAMILY/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on gun safety after a 4-yr-old boy got ahold of his Grandfather’s gun which was not locked up. The boy shot his finger while his parents were in the other room. A local police officer showed viewers some gun safety measures, including using a gun safe and a gun lock. He recommended gun owners take gun safety classes in order to figure out the safe gun storage method that works best for them. A U.S. Representative in Oregon is pushing for new gun safety legislation. He said laws have reduced injury and deaths associated with tobacco and vehicle safety, and they can do the same with gun violence.

CRIME/SAFETY/FAMILY/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on an increase in gang-related police calls in the Portland Area. A police spokesman said detectives are working hard to address the spike in gang violence, but they need tips from the public to solve these cases because not many witnesses or victims are cooperating. Surveillance video from a shooting in a parking garage was shown in hopes that someone will recognize the subject with a gun. This was one of 16 gang-related violent crimes Portland police responded to this year, all shootings, including six in just the first ten days of February. Portland residents we spoke with said they feel safe, but this much violence is upsetting. Meanwhile, Crimestoppers is offering a new reward to get guns away from felons and kids. Anyone who reports a convicted felon or child with a gun can get a minimum of \$250 cash reward and remain anonymous.

SOCIO-POLITICAL/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a controversy surrounding a motto one Clark County Councilor wanted to see in the public hearing room. "In God We Trust" was the national motto the councilor wanted to have added to what already read across the wall in the hearing room. Some thought it would be a good reminder of patriotism in the United States. But protestors outside the meeting did not want to see anything that said God. They said there should be no opinions on people's beliefs unless it represents everybody. It was voted down 2 to one.

ECONOMY ISSUES

This story focused on a South Korean Shipping Company which is moving its ships out of the Port of Portland. It holds nearly 80% of the business and will effect more than 650 jobs directly. Instead of coming to Portland, most companies will be moving product to Seattle because of a conflict between the port operator and the Longshore Workers Union that resulted in a work slowdown.

GOVERNMENT/CRIME ISSUES

These story segments focused on the resignation of Governor John Kitzhaber as the Department of Justice begins an investigation after the accusation that his fiancé, Cylvia Hayes, used her position and influence in the governor's office to secure contracts for her consulting firm. The Attorney General's investigation should reveal whether that happened, and if it did, how much the governor knew about it. Oregon Law says the Secretary of State will now step in as interim governor. Kate Brown is a fellow democrat and has worked alongside the governor for many years. She said she was sad for the state of Oregon, but is confident that legislators will come together to move Oregon forward.

SOCIO-POLITICAL/GOVERNMENT/CRIME ISSUES

This story focused on whether or not Governor Kitzhaber will use his power to halt executions for 34 inmates now on death row. Governor Kitzhaber announced a moratorium 4 years ago, saying he couldn't allow any more executions on his watch. His watch may be coming to an end, but he has one more chance to weight into controversy and make a lasting impact on the state. Family of one of the inmates victims have said justice will be denied if the governor commutes the sentence of the man who cold-bloodedly killed her sister and her nieces and nephew.

Air Date: 2/17/15 10PM News, Running Time:2:10

ENVIRONMENT/SAFETY ISSUES

This story focused on a new earthquake alert system that could help save lives. Earthquakes can hit without notice. But at University of Washington, the Pacific Northwest Seismic Network is testing out a new program called “Shakealert” that detects earthquakes before they hit, in some cases up to ten to twenty seconds before. That gives people time to find a safe spot, put away valuables or even turn off electricity to avoid fires. Sensors from seismographs pick up the first wave from an earthquake and then send that information to a computer. A few companies from the Northwest are already part of the trial. Providence Hospital and Microsoft already have computers set up to get the alert. There is still a lot more research that needs to be done and researchers don’t know when the technology will be fully implemented but are hoping they will eventually be able to send out warnings to your cell phone.

GOVERNMENT/SOCIO-POLITICAL ISSUES

This story focused on the swearing-in of a new Oregon State Governor after the previous governor resigned amid controversy. The new governor laid out her priorities hoping to move past the scandal and restore voter’s trust in government. To do that, Governor Brown pledged she, her family and staff members will not seek or accept outside compensation for any work related to the business of the state of Oregon. She said she’ll focus on the concerns of every day Oregonians and will work to create living-wage jobs and improve access to education and health care.

CRIME/FAMILY/SAFETY ISSUES

This story focused on the rescue of a local teenage girl from the sex trafficking world. The man accused of selling the 16-yr-old as a prostitute is now behind bars. A suspicious ad on a website led detectives to investigate. A detective posed as a customer and set up a date to meet with a female through the ad. Then police arrived, they found the escort was a 16-yr-old girl who was a missing and endangered teen from the Portland Area. The National Woman’s Coalition Against Violence and Exploitation says the issue of sex trafficking is something police agencies are dealing with more and more. The website is being used for prostitution, becoming such a problem that many cities, including Portland, have filed a lawsuit against them. Parents were reminded to know what their children were looking at and doing online.

Air Date: 2/23/15 6PM News, Running Time:2:00

CONSUMER/ECONOMY ISSUES

This story focused on the opening of nearly 30 ports on the West Coast, including Portland, after shipping companies and dock workers reached an agreement late Friday night. And even though it will take days to unload the backlog, the Port's major player will not return when it leaves in March. All the ports are resuming normal operation, averting a shutdown that could have cost the U.S. economy two billion dollars a day. This, after shipping companies and the union representing dock workers reached a tentative agreement over the weekend on a five year labor deal. Members of the union must still ratify the contract which is expected to happen in the coming days. Despite the resolution, analysts said it will take months for workers to clear the backlog of goods that have sat idle in containers at the ports. That's a problem for business owners who have seen their profits take a nose-dive and their costs increase since the dispute began.

MINORITY/CRIME ISSUES

This story focused on six companies being sued by shoppers seeking damages, saying they were targeted because of their skin color. One store manager told one of the shoppers that she was on a national database of shoplifters and claimed to have the video and pictures to prove it. The manager wouldn't show the images to the shopper or the police she called either. Her attorney said such a database doesn't exist and believes burns is a victim of shopping while black. This case is one of six lawsuits the attorney's firm recently filed on behalf of seven different people, alleging they suffered discrimination, false arrest or battery at stores around the Portland-Metro Area because of their race.

HEALTH/EDUCATION ISSUES

This story focused on a campaign by the University of Oregon to get students vaccinated a week after one of their students died suddenly from Meningococcal Disease. The campaign is called "Get The Vax" and the university said it's been offering the meningitis vaccine to students for a few weeks. The warning came after a freshman athlete died of the disease. Three other students have it and are now out of the hospital. Student leaders are trying to spread the word about the vaccine.

ENVIRONMENT/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a celebration by The Multnomah County Animal Shelter as they reached a combined "live release" rate over 90%. That means that 9 out of every 10 animals that enter the shelter are either adopted out, transferred to a different shelter or returned to their owners. The shelter manager said eight years ago more than half of the cats that came into the shelter ended up being put down. The shelter was thrilled with the progress and said it had the community to thank.

HEALTH/FAMILY/GOVERNMENT ISSUES

This story focused on a vote by the Oregon House of Representatives to ban sales of E-Cigarettes to minors, require E-Cigarettes and their components to be sold in child-resistant safety packaging and to add them to the state's smoke free workplace law. That means no one could "vape" in any workplace where smoking is not allowed. Multnomah County Commissioners will vote on a similar proposal in a few days. The Vice President of the Multnomah County Vaping Association said they support the regulations and most shops already ban sales to minors. But they were demonstrating outside the County Building to ask commissioners to exempt "Vape Shops" from the Smoke Free Workplace Law where they say customers go to sample and learn to use products. If the shops can't do that, they said it could put them out of business.

CONSUMER/SAFETY ISSUES

This story focused on a recall by Hyundai. The company said more than 200 thousand of its vehicles could have a power steering defect. The problem could increase the risk of a crash. The recall affects Elantra Sedans made between 2008 and 2010 as well as 2009 to 2010 Elantra touring Hatchbacks. The company estimated about three percent of those vehicles have a defect that disables the steering assistance. Hyundai will contact owners affected and will cover the cost of the fix.

MINORITY/SOCIO-POLITICAL/CRIME ISSUES

This story focused on a civil lawsuit filed by Michael Brown's parents in their son's death one day after a justice department report outlined discrimination by police in Ferguson, MO. The Department of Justice decided not to charge the officer who shot and killed Brown last August. The Brown Family Attorney said they plan to demonstrate that the choice to use deadly force was unnecessary under those circumstances.

POVERTY/ECONOMY ISSUES

This story focused on the launch of the Chain Reaction Bike Co-Op. People down on their luck in Portland can now get free bike repair training, and eventually their own bike. Organizers said it's a chance to learn something and earn something. Central City Concern is teaming up with Bikes For Humanity PDX for the program. Clients can sign up, then are taught how to repair and refurbish their own bikes or one that's donated.

CONSUMER/CRIME ISSUES

This story focused on an undercover sting operation involving illegal moving companies that resulted in two arrests. The Oregon Department of Transportation said there are dozens of illegal moving companies operating in the state. ODOT said when you hire these companies, you're putting yourself and your belongings at risk. Oregon requires all moving companies to get state certification. The sting operation in Southeast Portland showed the risks people take when hiring non-certified movers. The sting turned up college students recruited by an illegal company and another company with a mover who admitted to smoking pot before he showed up and was cited for pot possession. Two different moving companies had hired men with warrants out for their arrest. Officials said hiring certified movers can protect you and keep you from getting scammed. Those companies must meet insurance requirements, do background checks on employees, operate safe vehicles and charge approved rates.

EDUCATION/ECONOMY ISSUES

This story focused on a proposed budget cut that would take 4 million dollars from the Beaverton School District alone. That's equal to salaries for 41 teachers. Instead of just hoping that legislators will approve a healthy budget, the principal of one local high school sent home a form letter to families urging them to send it to their state senator or representative. Students are doing the same on social media, all to tell lawmakers they need adequate funding. The budget on the table right now would mean 4.1 million dollars less for Beaverton schools, so students started a Twitter campaign, showing they were willing to speak up after realizing their own future was at stake. Nothing is written in stone yet and students just hope their voices count.

HEALTH/EDUCATION ISSUES

This story focused on an emergency vaccination clinic held at the University of Oregon after a 19 year old sophomore ended up in the hospital with a blood infection that can cause meningitis. That same infection killed an 18 year old student last month and left three other students sick. The university teamed up with Safeway to offer a clinic at the apartment complex of the latest sick student. This comes after a massive four-day vaccination clinic that was held at Matthew Knight Arena. Students can also get free vaccinations at the university health center.

ENVIRONMENT/SAFETY ISSUES

These stories focused on the wind storm that hit the city, knocking down power lines, scaffolding and many trees causing lots of damage. Many streets and businesses were closed and thousands of people were without power.

SOCIO-POLITICAL/CRIME/SAFETY ISSUES

This story focused on a local protest motivated by the shooting of Michael Brown in Ferguson. A group of 30-50 protesters wearing masks and all black walked into the street and blocked traffic. Then they entered a Walgreens, chanting and causing chaos and damage to store merchandise. They did the same thing in a Safeway store and one witness said she froze in fear. There were no arrests, but Portland Police said they are working with the store managers to try and identify the suspects.

CONSUMER/SAFETY ISSUES

These stories focused on recall alerts. Kraft voluntarily recalled boxes of the original flavor Mac and Cheese because some boxes may contain small metal pieces. The boxes could be returned to the store for a refund or exchange. Also, Trader Joe recalled several of its raw walnut products because of possible Salmonella contamination. Trader Joe encouraged customers to throw out the products or return them for a full refund.

EDUCATION/FAMILY ISSUES

This story focused on a new technology being used to help special education students communicate and learn. It's called "Eagle Eye" and used electronics attached to the face to track eye movement that gets translated onto a computer screen. The parents of one 12-yr-old girl said their daughter really blossomed after using it at school. They said it helps her learn things that would otherwise be much more difficult. The program was developed by grad students as a fun way to pass time. It's now used in several schools around the country after seeing the positive effect it has on special needs kids.

CRIME/GOVERNMENT/SAFETY ISSUES

This story focused on lawmakers who are trying to stop the growing problem of the dangerous and highly flammable hash oil. Last year alone, at least ten people in Oregon ended up in Legacy Emanuel's Burn Unit. Although it is mostly the guys cooking the oil that get badly burned, one child suffered broken bones after escaping a butane hash oil explosion and one 87-year-old woman died when she was forced to jump for safety after another explosion. Hash oil is a highly concentrated form of Marijuana. In Oregon, many cooking up hash oil have medical marijuana cards and despite the dangerous explosions, most have faced only minor charges. Lawmakers are looking at revising Oregon's Arson Law so that hash oil manufacturers would face first or second degree arson charges. In some cases, this would be a Measure 11 crime and those convicted could face serious prison time.

This story focused on a recall on frozen meals from “Amy’s Kitchen”. The company said 74 thousand cases of its frozen foods that include spinach may be contaminated with Listeria. The recall is voluntary and no illnesses have been reported.

GOVERNMENT/SOCIO-POLITICAL ISSUES

This story focused on a ban by Portland’s Mayor on government travel to Indiana on the heels of a new controversial law. The Mayor says he hopes to send a message to Indiana Lawmakers by not sending any Portland City Workers to the state anytime soon. Critics of the new Religious Freedom Restoration Act said the legislation will lead to discrimination against the Gay and Lesbian Community. Local LBGTQ Organizations have been closely following the new law. The Governor of Indiana and other lawmakers said the bill is to make sure businesses aren’t forced to do something that goes against their owner’s religious beliefs.
