

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CEDAR BROADCASTING, INC.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is CEDAR BROADCASTING, INC.

ARTICLE II

This corporation is a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the non-profit public benefit law for public purposes. The public purposes of the corporation is to own and operate educational radio stations transmitting in the Arabic language.

ARTICLE III

The name and address in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is: ELI TAWIL, 1034 W. Arrow Highway, Suite "D-105", San Dimas, CA 91773.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of IRC Section 501(c)(3). No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise

attempt to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE V

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to public and educational purposes and no part of that net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

ARTICLE VI

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for public educational purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under IRC Section 501(c)(3).
