**NBC BAY AREA, THE BAY AREA TODAY 6:00PM-7:00PM 4/1/11 REPORTED...** GOVERNOR BROWN HAS HIS SIGHTS SET ON PENSION REFORM, BUT NEITHER SIDE OF THE AISLE SEEMS PLEASED WITH HIS LATEST PROPOSALS. HIS PLAN PUTS A STOP TO PENSION SPIKING-- THAT'S WHERE PENSIONS ARE INFLATED BY A BIG RAISE IN THE LAST YEAR. THE PROPOSED REFORMS AREN'T SITTING WELL WITH UNIONS. THEY ARE UPSET THE GOVERNOR IS TAKING A "BLANKETED" APPROACH TO REFORM AND CLAIM HE COULD GET THE SAME RESULTS THROUGH COLLECTIVE BARGAINING. REPUBLICANS, WHO HAVE BEEN CALLING FOR PENSION REFORM FOR YEARS, ARE NOT IMPRESSED EITHER. SAYING THE PROPSALS DONT GO FAR ENOUGH.

KEENAN WILL TAKE MORE THAN 3-MILLION DOLLARS IN SEVERANCE -- WHEN HE RESIGNS LATER THIS MONTH.

**NBC BAY AREA, THE BAY AREA TODAY 6:00PM-7:00PM 4/11/11 REPORTED...**STATE LEGISLATORS ARE INTRODUCING A BILL DESIGNED TO PROHIBIT CALIFORNIA PROFESSIONAL SPORTS TEAMS FROM AGREEING TO MOVE TO OTHER CITIES.. UNLESS THE TEAMS SATISFY ALL FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS TO THE PLACES THEY'RE MOVING FROM. THE SENATE BILL ALSO REQUIRES ANY PRO SPORTS FRANCHISE THAT'S PREVIOUSLY ENTERED INTO A FINANCIAL AGREEMENT WITH A CALIFORNIA CITY TO PROVIDE A BOND OR DEPOSIT.. THAT WOULD BE ADEQUATE TO ENSURE ITS OBLIGATIONS ARE TAKEN CARE OF BEFORE A TEAM MOVES AWAY.THE BILL WOULD TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY IF IT PASSES. IT REQUIRES A TWO-THIRDS MAJORITY VOTE.

**NBC BAY AREA, THE BAY AREA TODAY 6:00PM-7:00PM 4/1/11 REPORTED...**A man who was found dead at a home in East Oakland Thursday morning has been identified as 22-year-old Evan Meisner of Oakland, a police spokeswoman said today. Officer Holly Joshi said officers went to the 4000 block of Lyon Avenue at about 8:30 a.m. Thursday when a citizen reported finding a dead man inside a residence.Officers found Meisner unresponsive and suffering from apparent gunshot wounds, Joshi said.

Paramedics came to the home and pronounced Meisner dead at the scene, she said. The motive for the murder is still under investigation, and no suspects have been arrested, Joshi said. Police said anyone with information about Meisner's death is asked to call the homicide unit at (510) 238-3821.

THE CASE BEGAN WITH THE TEENAGER SEEKING MONETARY DAMAGES AGAINST SEVEN FORMER PLAYERS AND THE OWNER OF THE HOME WHERE THE PARTY TOOK PLACE. BUT EARLY ON, THE CASE FALTERED, AS CHARGES AGAINST ALL BUT TWO OF THE PLAYERS WERE DISMISSED. IN CLOSING ARGUMENTS YESTERDAY, THE MERCURY NEWS QUOTES AN ATTORNEY FOR ONE OF THE YOUNG MEN AS SCOFFING THAT THE ALLEGED VICTIM WAS QUOTE-- "ON A MISSION FOR MILLIONS."

THE COOPERATIVE EFFORT WILL INCREASE THE NUMBER OF SWAT OFFICERS AND ALLOW THEM TO SHARE RESOURCES. THE NEW TEAM WILL BE ABLE TO RESPOND TO INCIDENTS IN ANY OF THE THREE COMMUNITIES.

THE JUDGE IN THE CASE DENIED A DEFENSE ATTORNEY'S REQUEST ASKING FOR A BAN. THEY LEARNED OVER THE WEEKEND THAT A NEWSPAPER REPORTER RECEIVED A DEATH THREAT WHILE REPORTING A STORY RELATED TO "YOUR BLACK MUSLIM BAKERY". WHEN THE JUDGE ASKED THE JURORS IF THEY'D READ ANY ARTICLES ABOUT THE TELEPHONE DEATH THREAT MADE TO THE REPORTER, NONE OF THEM SAID THEY HAD.
