### **Section I. Issues.**

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter:

- A. WTL News Programming:** WTL continued its production of *Perspective* as a news magazine outlet for the community.
- B. Public Service Campaign:** WTL has supported LTHS's Relay for Life. While the actual event is not until April, WTL has been active in the community to raise awareness of not only the event, but also the effects of cancer.
- C. LTHS Basketball:** The community, as always, asks that WTL provides live play-by-play coverage of LTHS Boys and Girls Basketball and again this Winter WTL was able to meet this need.

### **Section II. Responsive Programs**

The station has broadcast programming dealing with each of the above-referenced issues.

Programming dealing with each issue is set out below:

#### **A. WTL News Programming:**

**Perspective** - WTL, under the leadership of Karl Krull '15, began a new news magazine program called *Perspective*. Each month, beginning in September, WTL students put together this one-hour program that focused on a different topic each time. For January 2015 the topic was the New Year. February 2015 was Non-Commercial Radio. And March 2015 was Volunteerism. These programs combined provided listeners with 3 hours of community intensive and focused news.

#### **B. Public Service Campaign**

**Relay for Life:** In order to raise awareness for cancer prevention and fund raising, WTL aired more than 4 hours worth of Public Service Announcements for Lyons Township High School's Relay for Life program, which since its inception more than 10 years ago has raised nearly \$1,000,000 in funds for the American Cancer Society.

### C. LTHS Student Sports

**Live Sports Broadcasts:** LTHS community members consistently ask that WTLT provide play-by-play coverage for LTHS sports. During the winter to satisfy this need, WTLT provides play-by-play coverage of both Boys and Girls Basketball. WTLT was able to provide coverage to our community through the broadcast of 6 boys basketball games (airtime total of 9 hours) and 3 girls basketball games (airtime total of 4.5 hours).
