**Issue**

Fire damages several homes within our service area annually. An uptick of such disasters usually happens during the coldest months of the year.

**Program Solution**

The stations host a house band weekly within our community room theater to raise money for our in-house charity, X Cares. The organization uses such funds to provide care to those who've lost items in house fires. Though some have full insurance coverage, several do not and such considerations are made when providing assistance to those in need. The funds are also used to support those with illnesses as well. During the second Quarter of 2018, an estimate of \$1,00.00 was disbursed among four families in need of aid.

**Issue**

Severe spring storms threaten the radio stations' service area with damaging winds, heavy rain, and hail.

**Program Solution**

The stations will cease normal operations and will offer hyper-local weather coverage for our 11-county primary service area. The station's personnel, trained in atmospheric sciences, track the storms from the time that dangers are first detected with the use of the region's only weather radar operated by a radio broadcast facility. With coordination with our communities EMA offices and the National Weather Service, potentially life-saving information is transmitted across our family of 17 frequencies.

**Issue**

The Lawrence County, TN Reserve Deputies Association seeks to raise funds to purchase new equipment for their officers by hosting an annual rodeo event at Lawrenceburg's Rotary Park.

**Program Solution**

The stations gave the agency ample air time to garner support for their cause. The station donated regular spots, walk-in visits, call-ins, and a social media push for our listenership to gain knowledge of the event.

**Issue**

Every year several non-profit Giles County organizations seek funds for their continued operation. Annually, groups enter the station's consideration for the Radio Auction fundraiser. The annual event has recently garnered selected non-profits up to \$50,000 dollars in funds to use toward their cause.
