WDWS PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Champaign Multimedia, LLC acquired WDWS, WHMS, WKIO from News-Gazette, Inc. in November 2019

Since 1990 WDWS has been a News-Talk-Sports programmed station. Locally produced talk programing 5A-11A, 4P-6PM, Monday thru Friday. Live local programs Saturday 8A-11A, Sunday 6A-10AM. The station has the market advantage of being a 24 News Operation which enables WDWS to respond instantly to situations and emergencies that affect our local communities.

Below are the programs from which we generate our response and/or coverage regarding local issues as identified on the following pages. The topics addressed are just a small sample of how WDWS serves our communities all day, all night, all weekend.

PNY: "A Penny For Your Thoughts" A daily (M-F) live local two hour talk show airing from 9a til 11a. This program allows for listener participation via the phone, email and text. Content ranges from newsmaker interviews, local civic leader interviews, celebrity interviews to open line segments. During open line listeners drive the topics. Everyone is welcome to participate. (Public Affairs)

MS: "Morning Show" Interview segments during the Morning Show between 5-9am (M-F). Newsmakers and local leaders are interviewed by the morning show crew. (Public Affairs)

<u>NWS</u>: "News Segment" Specific extended stories or special series packages prepared and delivered by our joint broadcast and print news department.

<u>CI:</u> "Citizen Involvement" A series of pre-recorded programs. (Public Affairs)

<u>SA</u>: "Station Announcement" A series of short messages in support and or in conjunction with WDWS community engagement projects.

Key Third Quarter 2023 Issues

Guns & Crime Incidents involving the discharge of a firearm continues to be a strong community concern. Local Economy A variety of positive growth patterns of tourism, retail, health care, new businesses, infrastructure and more. No Cash Bail/Safe-T Act Implementation Addressed in newscasts on: July 11th, July 12th, July 13th, July 18th, July 19th, August 17th, September 8th, September 14th, September 18th, September 20th, September 21st, September 22nd.

Education Plenty of discussion within community school districts, private schools, Parkland Community College, Danville Area Community College and the University of Illinois. Primary focus on how the various items affect local families. Addressed in newscasts on: July 12th, July 21st, August 3rd, August 4th, August 11th, August 15th, August 16th, August 18th, August 25th, September 11th, September 14th, September 15th, September 21st, September 22nd.

Willard Airport The work being done to attract additional scheduling and new airlines. Also the discussion about the U of I's administration of the airport. Addressed in newscasts on: July 19th, September 15th, September 27th, September 29th.

Immigration Impact locally, within Illinois and nationally on the continuous flow of immigrants. The stress it is placing on governmental resources. Addressed in newscasts on: August 15th, August 21st, August 24th, August 25th, August 31st, September 1st, September 5th, September 7th.

Kingfisher The U of I student movement to adopt a first time ever university mascot. Addressed in newscasts on: July 17th, August 3rd, August 17th, August 29th, September 6th, September 7th.

Local Police and Fire Administration Changes in the Champaign Fire Department, Urbana Police Department and the U of I Police Department. Addressed in newscasts on: July 20th, August 3rd, August 4th, August 11th, August 17th, August 23rd, August 28th, August 29th, September 7th, September 14th, September 18th, September 20th, September 26th.

Each weekday morning the DWS Morning Show devotes time talking with various newsmakers and journalists, all live, mostly in studio.
