

Issues of public interest to our listeners are identified through cooperation with community leaders, organizations serving our local community and a cross section of our audience. The station addresses these issues by providing the following services:

Weather: The station's meteorologist provides timely, customized weather reports for the towns of the lower and outer cape every hour. These one-minute reports are updated three times a day (or more as conditions warrant) and air every hour, seven days a week.

Ad Council PSAs: The station routinely receives national and regional PSAs produced by The Ad Council. These announcements are hand selected and aired according to our determination of the current issues facing our listeners.

“What's Goin' On” Featurette: The station routinely receives information about events of a fund-raising, charitable or non-profit nature from local organizations. Individual recordings are made highlighting and promoting only one event per recording. These 30-second recordings air every hour, seven days a week.
