Immersion school in Ontario reversing effects of assimilation through outdoor curriculum

Angelea Preston travelled to the Six Nations Reserve in Ohsweken, Ontario, Canada and spent the day with the students, teachers, and co-founders of the school. The curriculum is taught outdoors entirely. The students only go inside for lunch. The school teaches the subjects of a traditional school but uses the Waldorf teaching method which emphasizes teaching the whole child holistically.
