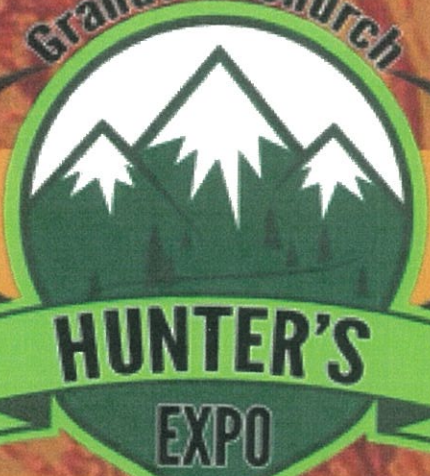

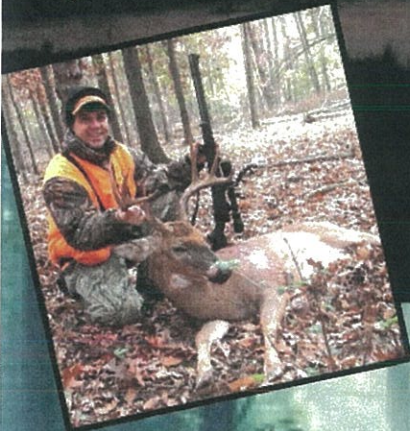

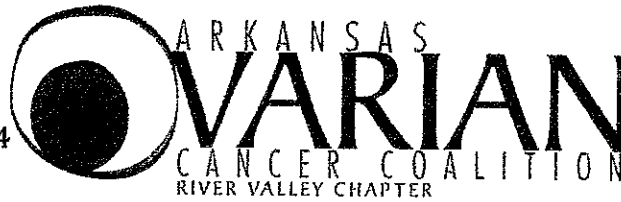

On behalf of the River Valley Chapter of the Arkansas Ovarian Cancer Coalition, thank you for your generous donation to our silent auction. The Wiederkehr Gift Card and four Eagle Crest gift certificates valued collectively at \$250.00 contributed to our silent auction total of \$9,138.00. This year's Teal Night in Tahiti event raised over \$34,000.00! You have helped us achieve an awesome amount to see to it that we continue to work towards our mission of educating people about ovarian cancer in the River Valley area.

Because of your support and generosity, we will continue to distribute educational brochures, bookmarks, and symptom cards at health fairs and community speaking opportunities. Awareness items such as car magnets, pens and pencils, lapel pins, and bracelets can be handed out, too. One initiative we are particularly proud to financially underwrite is the foundation of a gynecological cancer support group led by a licensed counselor which meets bi-monthly at the Reynolds Cancer Support House. \$50 gas cards are also provided for ovarian cancer patients who must travel out of town for treatment. The downtown Ferris wheel provides an opportunity for us to install teal bulbs for ovarian cancer awareness during the month of August. Teal ribbons promoting Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month for September were tied all along Garrison Avenue, too. Two free-to-the-public traditional activities hosted by our group are a TEAL Tea Party in the spring and a butterfly release during the month of September. All of these activities and programs are possible because of caring hearts such as yours.
