Lions Athletic Club Golf Tournament Set For Sept. 26

FORT SMITH, Ark. – Registration is now under way for this fall's UAFS Lions Athletic Club scholarship golf tournament. The annual event will be held on Monday, Sept. 26, at Fort Smith's Hardscrabble Country Club. There will be a morning and an afternoon flight. The morning flight will begin with a shotgun start at 8 a.m. The afternoon flight will begin at 1 p.m. with lunch being served prior to that at 11:30 a.m.

There are various levels of participation and entry fees.

Entry fee is \$600 for a regular, four-person team or \$150 for an individual player. Entry fee is \$1,000 for a four-person team with a driving range sponsorship; \$1,000 for a four-person team with a putting green sponsorship and \$800 for a four-person team with a hole sponsorship. A hole sponsorship is available for \$200.

All team entry fees include greens fees, golf cart rentals, lunch, refreshments and goody bags. Mulligans are an additional \$20 per player and \$80 per team. Great prizes will be awarded for first, second, third and last place. The names of the players on the winning team will be inscribed on a perpetual plaque and displayed year-

around in the Stubblefield Center.
