### True Grit Ride 100

June 22, 2013

The Community Services Clearinghouse Guild is hosting the Second Annual True Grit Ride 100, a non-competitive cycling tour for individuals of all abilities, including a 10-, 35-, 50-, 75- and 100-mile True Grit routes. Chuck Wagon aid stations are roughly 10 miles apart. New to the True Grit Ride this year is the 75-mile course for those who have mastered the 50-mile course but may still be in training for the 100. Along with becoming a popular cycling opportunity, the True Grit Ride supports the Community Services Clearinghouse, a non-profit organization that provides emergency assistance to families and children in need in seven counties of Arkansas and Oklahoma. The most well-known program the Clearinghouse offers is the Meals for Kids backpack program, which distributes over 2,500 sacks of weekend food each Friday to children who otherwise would go hungry before returning to class on Monday. Register at [BikeReg.org](http://BikeReg.org) (find directions at the Clearinghouse website.) Pre-registration is strongly encouraged. Charter Members are automatically registered each year. Riders 12 and older are eligible. Riders under 18 must have parental consent. Participants are also invited to a Pasta Party from 5-7 p.m. June 21, held at the First Tee of Fort Smith.
