



The Elks Annual Hoop Shoot Contest is a basketball free-throwing contest for all girls and boys ages 8 through 13. Participants must be 8 to 13 years old as of April 1, 2016. There is no entryfee to participate nor admission charge for spectators. Prizes for the Elks Hoop Shoot include: First through 3rd Placers receive trophies and Certificates; First Placers will also receive a t-shirt to wear at the District/State Level Contest on Feb. 6.
