Avoid using two 50mg doses for infants weighing ≥ 5 kilograms (≥ 11 pounds) to preserve supply of 50mg doses for infants weighing <5 kilograms (<11 pounds). This minimum wage rate applies to all employees, subject to a few limited exceptions. Correspondingly, exempt employees in California must earn no less than two times the state's minimum wage, or an annual salary of no less than \$66,560 (or \$1,280 per week) to meet this threshold requirement. Employers should post the Minimum Wage Order and the Wage Order applicable to their workplace at a worksite area accessible to employees. The wage orders can be downloaded and printed from the workplace postings page on the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) website here.</p>
