WITH THE INCREASED DEMAND FOR COVID-19 TESTING, THE FRESNO COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH (FCDPH) WOULD LIKE TO REMIND RESIDENTS TO USE CREDIBLE COVID-19 TESTING SITES AND VENDORS FOR SERVICES. OVER THE LAST FEW WEEKS THERE HAS BEEN AN INCREASE IN POP-UP TESTING CLINICS ON STREET CORNERS, IN PARKING LOTS, AND ON SHOPPING CENTER PROPERTIES ACROSS THE COUNTY. IN SOME CASES, THESE POP-UP SITES CAN BE UNREGULATED, UNAPPROVED, AND COULD LEAD TO FRAUDULENT ACTIVITIES LIKE IDENTITY THEFT. THE FCDPH RECOMMENDS THAT RESIDENTS VERIFY THE CREDIBILITY OF TESTING SITE BEFORE SEEKING SERVICES.

FOUR PEOPLE WERE CAUGHT ON CAMERA STEALING THOUSANDS OF DOLLARS WORTH OF MERCHANDISE FROM THE KOHL'S DEPARTMENT STORE IN NORTHWEST FRESNO. OFFICERS WITH THE FRESNO POLICE DEPARTMENT SAY FOUR SUSPECTS JUMPED OUT OF A GOLD GMC YUKON ON FRIDAY, JAN. 28, AND WALKED INTO THE STORE. THEY ARE THEN SEEN CASUALLY WALKING AROUND THE STORE, SEPARATELY, WITH SEVERAL ITEMS IN HAND. ONCE THEY GATHER THEIR FILL, THEY DECIDE TO LEAVE WITH OVER \$2,000 WORTH OF ITEMS.

AUTHORITIES ARE INVESTIGATING AFTER A BODY WAS FOUND AT A HOME THAT CAUGHT FIRE IN CLOVIS ON TUESDAY MORNING. FIREFIGHTERS WERE CALLED TO A HOUSE ON ARGYLE AVENUE IN A NEIGHBORHOOD NEAR CLOVIS AND GETTYSBURG AVENUES AROUND 5:30 AM. AS CREWS WORKED TO PUT OUT THE FLAMES, THE BODY WAS DISCOVERED. IT WASN'T IMMEDIATELY CLEAR IF THE BODY WAS FOUND INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE HOME. POLICE ARE WORKING TO DETERMINE THE CAUSE OF DEATH. THE CAUSE OF THE FIRE IS ALSO UNDER INVESTIGATION.

COUNTY OFFICIALS IN NORTHERN CALIFORNIA ARE ANNOUNCING PLANS TO MOVE AWAY FROM MASK MANDATES ONCE THE STATE'S LATEST ORDER ENDS. ON TUESDAY, FEB. 15, CALIFORNIA'S INDOOR MASKING REQUIREMENT WILL END FOR VACCINATED PEOPLE, BUT MASKS STILL ARE THE RULE FOR SCHOOL CHILDREN. GOV. GAVIN NEWSOM'S ADMINISTRATION BROUGHT BACK THE MASKING MANDATE IN MID-DECEMBER AS THE OMICRON VARIANT GAINED MOMENTUM, AND LAST MONTH EXTENDED IT THROUGH FEB. 15. COUNTIES THAT HAVE DECIDED TO ALIGN THEIR LOCAL GUIDANCE WITH THE STATE'S GUIDANCE ARE YOLO, SOLANO, SUTTER, YUBA, PLACER, SAN JOAQUIN, STANISLAUS AND EL DORADO.

TUESDAY MORNING STARTED OFF WITH SOME LIGHT SNOW IN THE SIERRA, LEADING TO SLICK ROADS AND CHAIN CONTROLS IN THE HIGHER ELEVATIONS. A RELATIVELY WEAK AREA OF LOW PRESSURE DROPPED DOWN INTO SOUTHERN NEVADA, ALLOWING FOR FLAKES TO FLY IN THE MOUNTAINS. A COATING OF UP TO AROUND 3 INCHES OF SNOW ABOVE 4,000 FEET IN ELEVATION. CALTRANS' MAP SHOWED CHAIN CONTROLS STARTING ON EASTBOUND INTERSTATE 80 AT KINGVALE AND WESTBOUND I-80 AT RAINBOW ROAD. CHAINS ARE ALSO REQUIRED IN THE AREA OF TWIN BRIDGES ON HIGHWAY 50 AND PEDDLER VISTA ON HIGHWAY 88. IN ALL CASES, CHAINS WERE REQUIRED ON ALL VEHICLES EXCEPT THOSE WITH FOUR-WHEEL AND ALL-WHEEL DRIVE.
