Re: Election of Must-Carry, Election of Cable Channel Positioning

Dear David King:

Pursuant to Section 76.64 of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, 47 C.F.R. § 76.64, television station **KORO** Channel **28**, **Corpus Christi, Texas** hereby elects “must carry” status on your cable system for the period beginning on January 1, 2006, and ending on December 31, 2008. It is our intent that this election be effective as to your cable headend or cable system located in **Ingleside** and each community served by the cable headend or cable system.

Under Section 76.57(d) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, 47 C.F.R. § 76.57(d), a signal carried in fulfillment of a cable system’s must carry obligations may be carried on any channel number as is mutually agreed upon by the station and the cable operator. Station **KORO** would prefer to be carried on a mutually agreed upon channel **2** or its current channel position of **9** and would like to confirm the possibility of such carriage by your system.

In the event that we are unable to reach agreement on a mutually acceptable channel, then television station **KORO** hereby elects, pursuant to Section 76.57(a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, 47 C.F.R. § 76.57(a) to be carried on Channel **28**, which is the channel number on which **KORO** is broadcast over-the-air.

You may receive more than one copy of this letter in our effort to ensure that this letter reaches the appropriate party at your cable system. Please contact me immediately at **361-883-2823** if you have any questions concerning this election.

It is the desire of **KORO** to have excellent relationships with all of the cable system operators within our market. We look forward to a continued, mutually profitable relationship with your company.
