PROGRAMMING STATEMENT

"Magnum Broadcasting, Inc. consummated the purchase of WGAY on August 2017. WGAY was taken off-the-air previously and remained silent as per a STA that expired September 21, 2017. WGAY resumed operations on September 6, 2017 but again went silent on September 10, 2017 due to Hurricane Irma. Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent was granted on October 4, 2017 for the period September 10, 2017 - April 02, 2018. The four days that WGAY was on-the-air during the third quarter of 2017 immediately preceded a catastrophic natural disaster and station personnel and resources were not available to produce local programming that would typically be broadcast. WGAY will feature programming that is reflective of the public issues and concerns in the city of license and service area when the station returns to the air."
