Amendment of Children’s Programming Report
Third Quarter 2015 – Third Quarter 2019

Pursuant to Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) rules, WBXJ-CD (“Station”) uploads regular reports regarding the children’s television programming the Station airs.¹ The reports are included in the Station’s online public inspection file. The Station timely uploaded the required report for the period covered by this amendment (Q3 2015 – Q3 2019); however, in preparing the reports, the Station inadvertently included an incorrect description when its programming changed to include a new show during the third quarter of 2015. That new show, titled “Underwater World,” was described as follows: “Will’s self-reliance causes friction within the team. The Rangers seek on of the Corona Aurora gems in the underwater ruins of Atlantis.” Unfortunately, after the mistaken description was used on the Q3 2015 report, the same description was duplicated on subsequent children’s television programming reports that included Underwater World.

Children’s television programming reports cannot be amended after they are filed. Therefore, to correct the description of Underwater World on reports during the relevant time period, the Station is including this amendment in its online public inspection file at the direction of FCC staff. The following correctly describes Underwater World:

This enlightening series was produced to introduce children and teens to the underwater world of our planet’s oceans.

¹ The Station now uploads an annual report to its online public inspection file. Prior to 2019, the Station uploaded the report on a quarterly basis.
