SUPPLEMENTAL RECRUITMENT INITIATIVES

The employment unit engaged in the following broad outreach initiatives in accordance with various elements of FCC Rule 73.2080(c)(2):

Participation in at least four (4) job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions.

The stations participated in the following job fairs during the reporting period: 1) CUNY’s Kickstart Your Career Fair (January, 2022); 2) NABJ (National Association of Black Journalists) and NAHJ (National Association of Hispanic Journalists) Convention and Career Fair (August, 2022); 3) Think Public Media recruiting and virtual career fairs (March, 2022 and ongoing); 4) NGLIA (The Association of LGBTQ Journalists) Convention (September, 2022); 5) University of Connecticut Journalism Career Fair (March, 2022); 6) Quinnipiac University School of Communications Career Connect Day (February, 2022).

Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

The stations have a robust internship program designed to train students and members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment. Eight (8) students participated in internships in radio talk show production and human resources. In addition, the stations were the recipient of grants from several individual and university funders, which funded thirteen (13) internships in the newsroom and social media areas. The total number of internships during the reporting period was twenty-one (21).

Listing of each upper-level category opening in a job bank or newsletter of media trade groups whose membership includes substantial participation of women and minorities.

The stations routinely advertise job openings in several job banks, including the *Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) Jobline*, Current's publicmediajobs.org, and the Media Financial Management Association (MFMA) Career Center job bank, and promote recruiting opportunities through diverse journalism conferences for the recruitment of people of color. Such conferences and conventions include the National Association of Black Journalists (NABJ), the National Association of Hispanic Journalists (NAHJ) and Asian American Journalists Association (AAJA).

Provision of training to management level personnel as to methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination.

During the reporting period, the stations initiated a company-wide diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) initiative with a third-party diversity consultant. The outcome of the initiative is an overall DEI Strategic and Training Plan. As part of this initiative, employees, including all management level employees, have participated in robust training sessions covering topics including *Unconscious Bias, Micro Aggressions, Micro Affirmations, and Allyship*, as examples. The Company also expanded its training offerings in a Phase 2 of the initiative to include topics such as Cultural Dexterity, Relationship Building, Communication Style, and Hierarchy.

Establishment of training or mentoring programs designed to enable employees to acquire skills to qualify for higher-level positions.

During the reporting period, the stations established a management training program with the Harvard Business School where four (4) senior or mid-level managers participated. Topics included *Authentic Leader Development, Accelerating the Careers of High-Potential Leaders*, and *Leading and Building a Culture of Innovation*. In addition, the station established a training program with LinkedIn, called "LinkedIn Learning", where three (3) employees participated in a variety of technical topics including photoshop and social media marketing.
