WHBC-AM Quarterly Issues-Programs List

WHBC-AM has had a long history of broadcasting programs which address community issues.

As evidenced by strong listenership over many decades, WHBC stands on its record of meeting the needs of our listeners.

In 2014, representative programming included:

Forty-eight (48) national newscasts per broadcast day from Fox News.

Nearly sixty (60) minutes of local news during the day.

Three and a half (3.5) hours of news, weather, traffic, sports and informational programming every weekday from 5:30 AM till 9:00 AM (Canton's Morning News, local talent).

Two (2) hours of issue-focused programming every weekday from 10:00 AM till 12:00 PM (Ron Ponder Show, local talent and studio guests).

Four (4) hours of sports and topical issue talk programming every weekday from 3:00 PM till 7:00 PM (Sam Bourquin Show, local talent and studio guests).

One (1) hour of educational programming twice weekly from 9:00 AM till 10:00 AM (various local programs, both live in studio and recorded locally).

As an LP-1 (Local Primary) station in our multi-county operational area, WHBC is a vital link in the relay chain which connects authorized notifiers to the listening public. Many hours of valuable airtime are given to this function each year.

WHBC keeps an electronic recording of all programming. We have done this on a continuous basis since 2007. Recordings are held for the lifetime of the physical media.

On any given weekday, WHBC programming will help our listeners wisely spend money, care for their children and the elderly, maintain their health, understand their government, become aware of entertainment and enlightenment in our community, be informed about inclement weather, hear and understand divergent points of view, be informed about happenings within our schools, and more.

An accounting of each utterance that addresses a community issue would require nearly one full-time equivalent worker, and would generate volumes of paper. Instead, we invite any person desiring to know how WHBC meets the public interest to listen to our library of recorded broadcast content.

A suitable listening environment within our studio building will be provided to interested persons.

EAS Activations For Current Quarter

WHBC-AM & WHBC-FM have a long established policy of relaying EAS messages critical to the safety and welfare of the listening public.

The community issue of public safety during threatening events (man-made or natural) is partially addressed by delivery of timely warnings over our broadcast facilities.

The community issue of children's welfare is partially addressed by the timely rebroadcast of child abduction messages originated by state of Ohio authorities.
