Posting the Certificate

The station must display this certificate either in plain view (e.g. on the wall in the entrance to the main studio) or in the station's FCC authorization binder at the main studio and must also verbally inform an FCC inspector of its existence should one visit the station.

Benefits of the Certificate

The FCC shall not conduct any type of inspection, investigation or audit for a period of three (3) years from the date of the certificate, except for a "Targeted Tower Safety Inspection", an inspection initiated by a complaint, or an inspection related to political or EEO materials required to be in the Public File.

A Targeted Tower Safety Inspection shall be limited to the antenna site(s) and its compliance with FCC regulations relating to tower lighting, tower painting, posting of tower structure registration, RF radiation and the fencing of an AM tower. It shall not include an inspection of other facilities of the station, including studios and the interior of the transmitter building.
