The purpose of the EEO Public File Report (396) is to comply with Section 73.2080(c)(6) of the FCC's 2002 EEO Rule. This Report has been prepared on behalf of the Station Employment Unit that is comprised of the following stations: WGGB, Springfield, MA and is required to be placed in the public inspection files of these stations, and posted on their web sites, if they have web sites.

Internship Program 2013

The station has an internship program as defined below:

Program Objectives:

1. Develop links with technical schools, universities and colleges to promote the station as a prospective employer.
2. Create a symbiotic relationship between interns and station employees.
3. Provide interns with opportunities for translating classroom theories into industry applications. Interns will have the chance to develop practical skills that will improve their chances for success with the broadcast industry.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. The applicant must be attending an accredited institution. Graduate students also are eligible. Preferably, applicants should be communication majors, though other majors may be considered.
2. The applicant must be at least 18 years of age.
3. The applicant must be in good academic standing, as defined by his or her academic institution.
4. The applicant must receive academic credit for the internship experience. He or she must be registered for college credit at his or her institution during the quarter or semester in which the internship is performed. Interns are not paid.
5. In addition to meeting the institution's eligibility requirements, the applicant must meet the station's eligibility requirements.

WGGB, Springfield, MA had a total of 49 interns during this period: 21 from UMass, 4 from Westfield University, 3 from WNEU, 3 from University of Hartford, 3 from Holyoke Community College, 1 from Ithaca, 1 from Emerson, 1 from Emmanuel, 1 from Marist, 1 from Vassar, 1 from Wellesley, 1 from Quinnipiac University, 1 from Iona, 1 from Endicott College, 1 from WNEU, 1 from Lyndon State, 1 from Worcester State, 1 from Colby-Sawyer, 1 from AIC and 1 from the Roger Williams.
