The Civilian Investigative Panel (CIP) provides for independent and impartial citizens' oversight of the Miami Police Department. Mr. Jacobs joins Jill to discuss how the agency empowers the community to be engaged with experts in mediation who believe that it provides each of the parties involved by providing a "safe space," protected by rules of confidentiality, where they can freely express their feelings and opinions. In this setting, mediation empowers police officers by allowing them to take an active role in shaping the settlement of the complaint. Mediation provides police officers with an opportunity to explain what they did and why. In the internal affairs review process, officers are required to explain themselves to investigators—from either internal affairs or a citizen oversight agency—but they have no opportunity to talk directly to the complainant.
