Community Spotlight - Monday thru Friday 7:00am

Community spotlight is a daily 15 minute program that provides a public forum for community leaders and event organizations to discuss current issues affecting the listening area. The program also provides information on upcoming events in Columbus and surrounding communities. The live 15 minute program provides great interaction between community leaders and the public. It is a great program for promoting positive programs and events in the area.

Y's Words - Monday thru Friday 9:00am

The two minute daily program is a discussion between local fitness experts at the Columbus YMCA. The program offers tips on healthy lifestyles and informs the public of education and interactive programs throughout the community. The program also informs the public of healthcare opportunities in the community.

Government and Politics	April 1 st to May 15 th	10	90 seconds	Aired stories on the debate between lawmakers who were both for and against giving wage cuts to student workers.
Government and Politics	April 5 th to May 20 th	12	30 seconds	Broadcast both sides of the legislature's decision to enforce a gas tax increase on the state.
Government and Politics	June 21 st and June 22 nd	4	90 seconds	Broadcast two days of stories on the NSAA deciding not to extend the current president's contract.
Education and Youth	April 1 st to May 6 th	2	10 minutes	Ran 2 in-depth feature stories to educate listeners of the goals of the D.A.R.E./G.R.E.A.T. programs in Schools.
Education and Youth	April 20 th to June 8 th	5	7 minutes	Aired several feature stories on Connect Columbus with how they educate healthy families and focus on Child abuse prevention.
Education and Youth	April 1st to June 30th	65	2 minute	Y's Words is a daily program that offers tips on healthy lifestyles and informs the public of education and interactive programs throughout the community. The program also informs the public of healthcare opportunities in the community.
Health	April 1st to June 30th	180	30 seconds	Blood Drive announcements run throughout the month to inform listeners on the importance of how crucial blood donations are in the listening area.

Health	April 1 st To June 20 th	20	30 seconds	Broadcast multiple informational features from The University of Nebraska College of Medicine on different health topics including healthy habits, allergy season, and sun exposure, and cancer support groups.
Health	April 13 th to June 22 nd	6	8 minutes	Broadcast in-depth features from the Columbus Community Hospital on introducing new physicians, education about health programs and new services, along with fundraising with the Foundation.
Weather	April 2 nd to June 4 th	3	6 minutes	Aired tips on safety preparedness from Platte County Emergency Management along with severe weather watching/precautions, new technology, and volunteer training opportunities.
Weather	April 20 th to June 26	20	90 seconds	Aired features informing the public of Monthly Tornado Siren testing in the Platte County Area. Also informed listeners about tornado safety tips.
Weather	May 14 th to June 10 th	15	30 seconds	Aired updates on flooding that occurred in Lincoln and York from torrential rains that plagued the area. Offered support services to victims of the flooding and tips on how to prepare in the case of flooding.
Weather	June 4 th to June 9 th	10	90 seconds	Broadcast numerous stories on the one year anniversary of the Pilger Tornados including what has taken place to rebuild the town. Also provided disaster recovery tips to listeners during the features.
Community Events	April 4 th to June 19th	9	7 minutes	In depth interviews with community leaders from Columbus United Way. Information on the 19 local agencies that benefit from the United Way
Community Events	May 21 st to May 24 th	3	6 minute feature 2-30 second short features	Aired in depth feature on the Creston Q-125 celebration explaining the history of the town, importance of the event, and events during the weekend celebration.
