ADDENDUM

NOTE: The preceding listings, as previously indicated, are some of the most significant broadcast material addressing the listed issues for the quarterly period, and are by no means exhaustive.

We feel that special note should be made of the nature of the station's broadcast operations, which nature is such that this preponderance of programming is in the categories of public affairs, religious, and educational programs. Further, our personnel, in numerous cases, have relatively high rates of personal contact with individuals and groups representative of the station's audience and the community leadership, in a wide range of activities.
