ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF WKTC RADIO CORPORATION

FILED THE UNDERSIGNED corporation hereby executes these Articles of Amendment for the purpose of amending its charter:

- 1. The name of the corporation is "WKTC Radio Corporation."
2. The following amendment to the charter of the corporation was adopted by its shareholders on the 16th day of August, 1984, in the manner prescribed by law:

That ARTICLE 1. of the Articles of Incorporation be amended to read as follows:

"The name of the Corporation is WHVN, Inc."

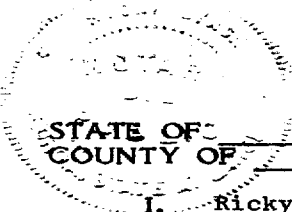
- 3. The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was Five Hundred (500); and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was Five Hundred (500).
4. The number of shares voted for such amendment was Five Hundred (500); and the number of shares voted against such amendment was Zero (0).
5. There shall be no change in the stated capital of the corporation as a result of this amendment.
6. The amendment does not give rise to dissenters' rights under Section 55-101(b) of the North Carolina General Statutes, because the amendment merely affects a change in the corporation's name.
