## **ISSUE: ECONOMY**

1. Fox 9 Now at 9 pm– August 16, 2017 – 45 seconds of a 60 minute program

Steelhead Season – For the first time in 43 years, anglers will not be allowed to catch and keep Idaho steelhead. This will be bad news for river communities that rely on the tourist dollars because of the limited salmon season this year.

Caldwell Construction – Businesses in downtown Caldwell say work downtown is impacting their wallets.
