KNBC and KVEA Internship Program

Internships are the perfect way to gain real world experience while learning what a career at KNBC and KVEA in Los Angeles might hold in store for them. Interns have produced tangible results as they begin building their professional networks, and for many, the internship experience confirms their professional goals. We offer opportunities throughout the News, Creative Services, Local Integrated Media, Human Resources and Sales departments. We provide college students with the opportunity to showcase their many talents and allow KNBC and KVEA to identify high potential talent for future staff hiring as well as YOH associate employees and the NBC Page program. KNBC and KVEA look for students who are committed to a career in media/broadcasting through experiences in their major studies, college

clubs/organizations, prior media based internships or prior media work experience. Grade point average, community service, and leadership experience are also an important part of the total assessment of student applicants. KNBC and KVEA work closely with local and out of state colleges and universities to build an active internship training program. During the current Annual Reporting year, a total of **93 Interns** have participated in the Internship program. Karina Avila, Human Resources Generalist coordinates with Campus 2 Career for internship placement throughout KNBC & KVEA. The program is offered during spring, summer, and fall semesters and is designed to accommodate a student's school schedule. Students are paid and may also receive college credit. Each internship period usually lasts two to three months.

Emma Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media

KNBC and KVEA is a proud sponsor of the **Emma Bowen Foundation**. The Emma L. Bowen Foundation was established by the media industry to help increase access to permanent job opportunities for minority students. The Foundation's program is unlike other intern programs in that students work for a partner company during summers and school breaks from the end of their senior year in high school until they graduate from college. During that four-year period, students have an opportunity to learn many aspects of corporate operations and develop company-specific skills. Students in the program receive an hourly wage, as well as matching compensation to help pay for college tuition and expenses. Mentoring from selected staff in the sponsoring company is also a key element of the program. Karina Avila, Human Resource Generalist coordinates and oversees the placement of students for both KNBC & KVEA. During the summer semesters, “Emma” students rotate in various KNBC and KVEA departments while gaining experience in every aspect in media. Number of interns during the reporting year: **1**

Internal Skills Enhancement Programs

Employees of the stations are provided with training and development opportunities designed to enhance their ability to assume positions of greater responsibility. Various programs are provided via external vendors and internal NBCUniversal-sponsored programs. In addition, online training is available. All employees can access our 33 free managerial skills modules via Harvard Manage Mentor. Courses include: Budgeting, Business Case Development, Business Plan Development, Career Management, Change Management, Coaching, Crisis Management, Customer Focus, Decision Making, Delegating, Developing Employees, Difficult Interactions, Diversity, Ethics at Work, Feedback Essentials, Finance Essentials, Global Collaboration, Goal Setting, Hiring, Innovation and Creativity, Innovation Implementation, Leading People, Leveraging Your Networks, Managing Your Boss, Marketing Essentials, Meeting Management, Negotiating, Performance Appraisal, Performance Measurement, Persuading Others, Presentation Skills, Process Improvement, Project Management, Retaining employees, Strategic Thinking, Strategy planning

& execution, Stress Management, Team Creation, Team management, time management & Writing skills.
