



As you all know, we are living in an interesting time right now. I wanted to give you an update and provide you with some information as we navigate the current situation of social distancing, limited movement, and craziness.

My office continues to be open with a skeleton crew in place and the following sign on the door. We have developed a rotation where the office is manned by a minimum of at least two people while others team members are working remotely.

Due to the current conditions as a result of the COVID-19 virus, the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Office of Hill County will be closed to public access. The County Extension Staff IS and WILL be available to assist you with your Extension related needs, however, we ask that you call the office first (254) 582-4022 or contact the agents by email.

AgriLife Extension has all face-to-face programming on hold through May 4<sup>th</sup> at the earliest. With that, many events and educational activities will not be conducted in the same manner as we had originally planned. Several County Extension Agents in the area are scrambling to offer programs and CEU's through internet-based webinars (Zoom, Microsoft Teams, WebEx, etc.).

We have received word from TDA that licensed applicators with expiring licenses or needing CEUs will be allowed to renew their license even if they have not met their CEU requirement for their current licensing period through December 31, 2020. Due to the restrictions of meetings in place by the Governor and many cities. The TDA will work to insure all the state's pesticide applicators are able to acquire their licenses and required continuing education courses in a safe and effective manner during this time frame. Once the restrictions have been lifted and courses are scheduled again, applicators will be required to obtain their required CEUs for their respective license classification for each licensing period. By allowing a CEU exemption, this will allow the applicators to maintain their ability to perform pesticide applications for pests, weeds, insects etc., without disrupting daily business functions. Applicators are encouraged to complete online courses even if online courses were completed the previous licensing period.

The Farm Service Agency (FSA) is now accepting applications for emergency farm loans due to damages and losses caused by drought occurring on November 1, 2019 and continuing in Anderson, Cherokee, Gregg, Henderson, Rusk, Smith, Upshur and Van Zandt Counties. Smith County Farm Loan Manager, Clinton Warrick, asks farmers who want to apply for emergency loans to submit their applications as soon as possible. The deadline for applications is November 7, 2020, but Warrick says if farmers wait too long, a backlog will develop and cause delays

Generally, farmers who have lost 30% of their production or any physical loss due to the disaster are eligible for the emergency loans.





