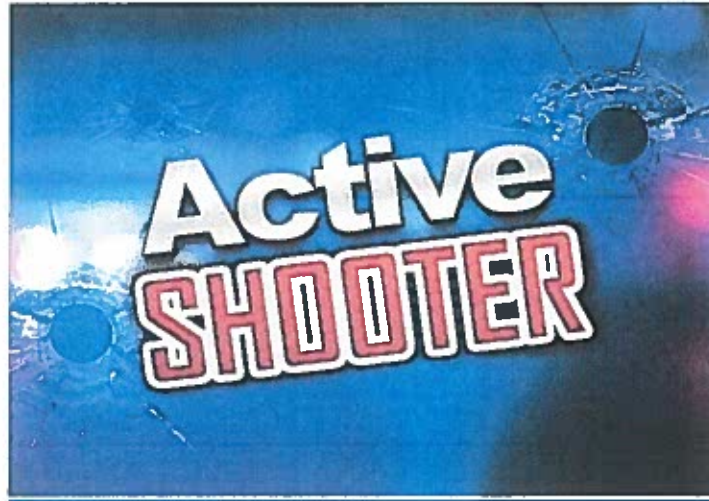

Active Shooter Training

As witnessed in a number of tragic events, terrible acts of violence continue to affect our lives and the lives of those we love. These events can happen anywhere at any time. Whether due to terrorism, work place violence, or the act of a mentally unstable person, our society continues to be the target of these attacks. Are you prepared? Sheriff Jeremy Shipley and the Freestone County Sheriff's Office are hosting this "free training" to the public. The course will be presented by Sgt. Darrell Coslin of the Smith County Sheriff's Office. Sgt. Coslin has 33 years of Law Enforcement experience, having served 30 years with the Dallas Police Department with duties that included Patrol Sgt., Detective, Academy Instructor and also as a full-time SWAT Officer. Sgt. Coslin is currently the public information Officer for Smith Co. S.O.

This training, "Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events", teaches what happens during an event. The human response both physical and psychological, common actions of the actor, law enforcement response and actions you can take to help you and your loved ones survive the attack.

The training will be held Tuesday, April 10th, from 6:00p.m. to 8:30p.m. at the Fairfield High School Auditorium , 631 Post Oak, Fairfield, Texas 75840

This subject is graphic and some portions of the training may not be suitable for children. Parents are strongly encouraged to "not" bring children younger than 13 to the training.

Electronics URT will accept IT electronics for recycling. URT clears all personal information to DOD standards. Acceptable items include: computers, monitors and all accessories, printers, ink cartridges, small copy/fax machines, cell phones, internet wires, cables, TVs, and power cords. **CRT TVs and CRT Monitors—limit of two per household. For a complete list of acceptable and not acceptable items please look on FISS website.

Batteries Batteries Plus Bulbs will accept NiCd, NiMH, lead, lithium ion batteries and batteries of AC/DC equipment. This includes car batteries.

Prescription eyeglasses, sunglasses, reading glasses, glasses frames and accessories will be accepted for donation to the Fairfield Lions Club.

Acceptable items for monthly RECYCLING:

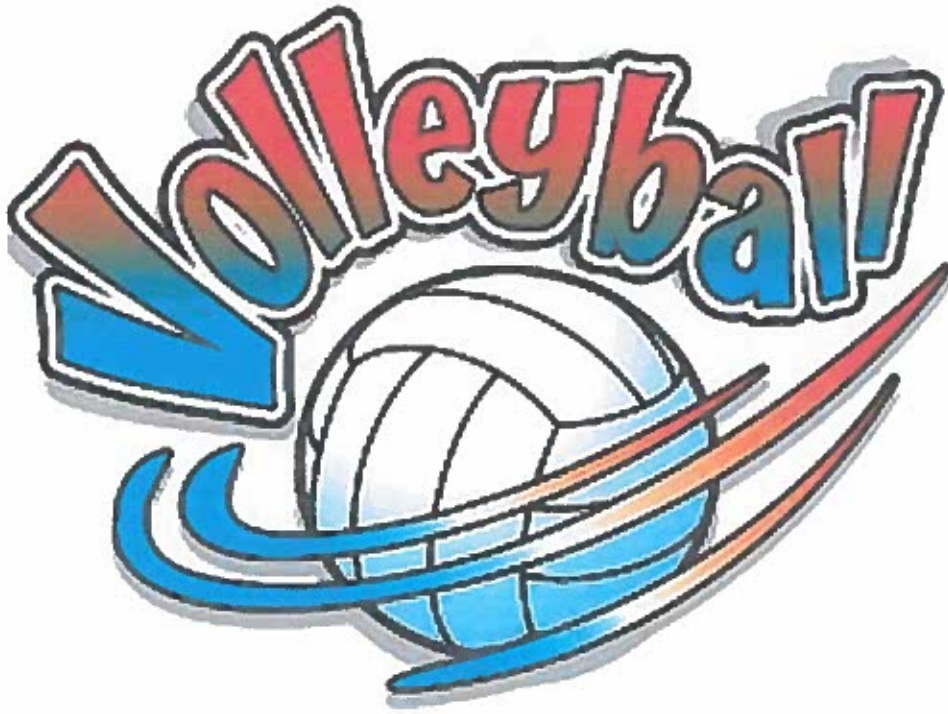
