# The blank canvas comes to Corsicana

Outdoor Painters Society to paint the town red and many other colors November 9 and 10

The phrase "a blank canvas" is often used to describe a journey that lies ahead or untold possibilities in the future. Soon, dozens of blank canvases will depict the lovely shapes and colors found around Corsicana.

The Outdoor Painters Society's "Paint Out" will bring dozens, perhaps even hundreds of artists practicing the tradition of "Plein Air" painting to town next weekend. ("en plein air" is a French term for outdoors. This method contrasts with studio paintings which might create a predetermined look.)

You will see these artists along our brick streets and city sidewalks, set back for a view of the Courthouse, or across the street from the historic State National Bank building. They might choose a historic home in the Carriage District or one more modern in Mills Place, set up on the porch at Pioneer Village or in the country on a farmhouse veranda.

More than working artists, these visitors are capturing the many facets of Corsicana and will make them available for sale at the Saturday Art Show and Reception from 4 to 6 p.m. on November 10<sup>th</sup> at the Warehouse Living Arts Center, 119 West 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

They will paint in various locations all day Friday, November 9, beginning with a breakfast and welcome at Across the Street Diner. Their day will conclude with an Artists' Reception at 100W followed by a visit to the Nancy Rebel Studio on Beaton Street, and finally, dinner at Napoli's, another storied location.

On Saturday, November 10, the painters will choose a location or two from a provided list: Canterbury Court, sponsor of this month's Mimosas at the Market, Palace Theatre and Warehouse Living Arts Center, Beaux-Arts architecture of the Corsicana Post Office, beautifully restored Navarro County Courthouse, two artist-favorite churches, St. John Episcopal Church and First United Methodist Church, or the Old City Jail, where a tour and lunch will be provided. A second lunch option will be the Veterans' Day celebration at the Corsicana Municipal Airport's C. David Campbell Field, sponsored by the Coyote Squadron. The schedule also includes other points of interest around town.

This is the first time the Outdoor Painters Society has visited, painted, and exhibited in Corsicana. The group organizes ten Paint Outs each year ranging from a day to as long as one week. Approximately 75% of the members reside in Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Louisiana, New Mexico, Arizona and Colorado. This Paint Out event is made possible by the Navarro Council of the Arts, who has organized the schedule and all activities, plus a grant from the Corsicana Visitors' Bureau.

The art exhibition is an opportunity for locals to own an original piece of art depicting a favorite place in Corsicana, a peaceful Texas landscape, or perhaps a location seen in a new light, passed by but never really noticed. A 'People's Choice' painting will be awarded \$250. As the entertainer Danny Kaye once said, "Life is a blank canvas; throw all the paint you can at it." That advice seems "plein" and simple.
