5. Photography entries will be judged in a private session by a panel of judges.
6. Photographs submitted may be **no larger** than 8" X 10", unmounted and unframed.
7. Photographs must be suitable for family viewing and the Chamber reserves the right to refuse entries.
8. Transparencies, slides, and digital files will not be accepted.
9. Photographs may be in color or black and white in all divisions (except black and white division where photos must be black and white.).
10. Photographers may enter as many photographs as they wish and each photo must be the work of the photographer.
11. Any violation of the contest rules will result in disqualification. NO REFUND.

Awards will be given for Best in Show and People's Choice (each age category) and first, second and third place in each division. Cash Prizes will be awarded to Best in Show in each age category except youth which will receive a scholarship.

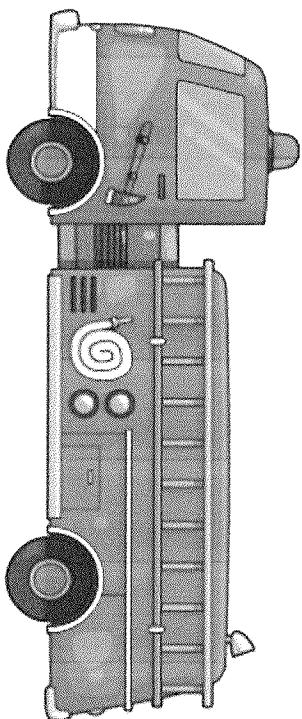

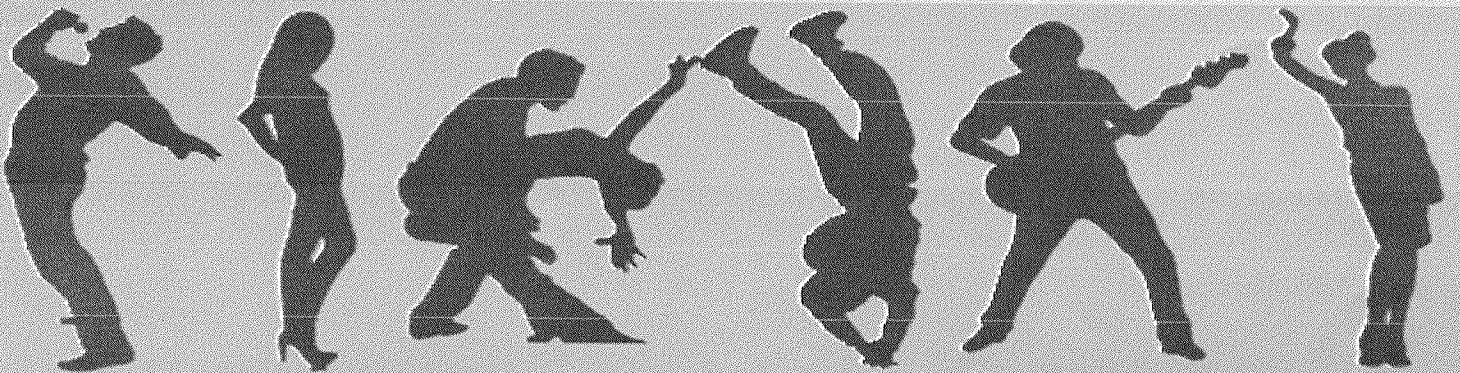
