Licensed in Mendota, WGLC-FM lends a great deal of focus on issues that concern the rural landscape as well as urban areas, in hopes that there is not an alienation of a group or groups of people and their varying lifestyles.

**Issue: Agriculture/Agribusiness**

*Agriculture and Agribusiness is a way of life for many in this area and we do our best to keep listeners up to date on these issues.*

Program: FFA. Broadcast a five minute interview with an FFA officer from Earlville. Aired 11/5 at 8:10am.

**Issue: Animal Welfare**

*"I am in favor of animal rights as well as human rights. That is the way of a whole human being." – Abraham Lincoln*

Program: Wallaroo. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that authorities hopped into action to capture a loose marsupial that jumped away from his owner. Aired 12/3 at 6:00am, 7:00am, 8:00am, 10:00am, and 12:00pm.

**Issue: Charity**

*Caring for the needy and less fortunate is an important function of a real community. We feel it is our job to keep listeners informed of developments, changes, and initiatives in this area.*

Program: Cops 4 Cancer. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the pink flags that dot the park in the Jordan Block in Ottawa are part of a fundraiser for Cops 4 Cancer, an area non-profit that assists cancer patients in North Central Illinois. Aired 10/16 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Coats for Kids. Broadcast several messages informing listeners about the coats for kids donation drive in Streator. Aired 11/1 for twenty-four seconds at 12:23pm. Broadcast two hundred and eleven thirty second PSAs informing listeners about the Coats for Kids donation drive and encouraging them to donate. See Appendix D for broadcast times.

**Issue: Community**

*Community organizations build a community bond and also are an outlet for charitable giving in a town.*

Program: Horse and Carriage. Broadcast three sixty second messages informing listeners that Santa will be riding around Mendota in a Horse and Carriage. Broadcast 12/15 at 6:20am, 7:30am, and 8:40am.

**Issue: Crime and Safety**

*Crime and Safety is always an important issue.*

Program: Barn Fire. Broadcast a fifteen second message informing listeners that a barn was destroyed in a Sunday morning fire near Peru. Aired 10/5 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: House Fire. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a ten year old is suspected of being the one who started a house fire in Marseilles. Aired 10/6 at 12:00pm.

Program: Hatchet. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a man is recovering from a serious non-life threatening injury after being struck by a hatchet outside a tavern in Bloomington. Aired 10/6 at 12:00pm.

Program: Kidnapping Plot. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that six people have been charged in federal court with plotting to kidnap Michigan Democratic Gov. Gretchen Whitmer at her vacation home. Aired 10/9 at 6:00am and 10:00am.

Program: Whereabouts. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that the Mendota Police Department are still looking into the whereabouts of a man they say has been missing since September twenty-second. Aired 10/13 at 6:00am.

Program: Recycling Business. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that thick black smoke filled the skies west of Ottawa after a car and other materials nearby reportedly caught fire at a recycling business. Aired 10/15 at 6:00am.

Program: Cybercriminals. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Federal agencies say cybercriminals are unleashing a major ransomware assault against the U.S. healthcare system. Aired 10/29 at 6:00am, 8:00am, and 12:00pm.

Program: Bribery Scheme. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that four people, including an associate of Illinois House Speaker Michael Madigan, have been charged with orchestrating a bribery scheme in Commonwealth Edison. Aired 11/19 at 6:00am, 8:00am, and 12:00pm.

Program: Phone Scam. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Illinois State Police District seventeen in LaSalle are warning residents about another phone scam that is attempting to steal personal information or money. Aired 12/16 at 6:00am, 8:00am, and 10:00am.

Program: Antitrust. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that as a wave of antitrust actions surges against Google and Facebook, state in two lawsuits are stretching beyond the cases made by federal competition enforcers to level bold new claims. Aired 12/18 at 7:00am and 12:00pm.

Program: Bombing. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that a motive for the Christmas Day bombing in downtown Nashville remains elusive. Aired 12/30 at 6:00am.

Program: Gunfire. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that the man accused of firing a gun at officers in Oglesby is expected to appear in court and be charged with multiple offenses. Aired 12/31 at 6:00am, 7:00am, 8:00am, and 12:00pm.

### **Issue: Coronavirus**

*With the rise of COVID-19, it is important for everyone to be fully informed on the situation and be aware of how it is changing.*

Program: President. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Trump announces that he and Melania Trump have tested positive for the coronavirus after exposure to top aide. Aired 10/2 at 6:00am and 10:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Democratic Joe Biden is offering sympathy to President Trump over his coronavirus diagnosis while casting the moment as a reminder of the health crisis facing the United States. Aired 10/3 at 8:00am.

Program: COVID-19 Relief. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Trump has called an abrupt end to negotiations with Democrats over additional COVID-19 relief, delaying acting until after the election despite warnings from his own Federal Reserve chairman about the deteriorating conditions in the economy. Aired 10/7 at 6:00am and 8:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that new virus relief will have to wait until after the November election. Aired 10/19 at 6:00am and 10:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that governors and state lawmakers are racing to get pandemic relief to small-business owners, the unemployed, renters, and others whose livelihoods have been upended by the widening coronavirus outbreak. Aired 11/30 at 7:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Congressional leaders appear to be on the brink of a COVID-19 economic aid package. Aired 12/17 at 7:00am and 12:00pm. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Trump is threatening to veto Congress' massive pandemic relief package in the midst of a raging pandemic and deep economic uncertainty. Aired 12/23 at 6:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Trump has signed into law a nine hundred billion dollar pandemic relief package, ending days of drama over his refusal to accept the bipartisan deal. Aired 12/28 at 6:00am and 8:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the House has voted overwhelmingly to increase COVID-19 relief checks to two thousand dollars, meeting President Trump's demand for bigger payments. Aired 12/29 at 8:00am.

Program: Blame. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Gov. Pritzker says President Trump and his allies are partly to blame for the surge in coronavirus cases in the state. Aired 10/19 at 8:00am.

Program: Challenge Study. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that U.K. researchers are preparing to begin a controversial experiment that will infect healthy volunteers

with the new coronavirus to study the disease in hopes of speeding up development of a vaccine. Aired 10/20 at 7:00am and 12:00pm.

Program: Indoor Dining. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Illinois Department of Public Health has announced that not only is indoor dining not allowed in Northwestern Illinois, but there is a limit to just ten people at any social gathering. Aired 10/23 at 7:00am and 10:00am.

Program: Food Pantry. Broadcast a fifteen second message informing listeners that the Illinois Valley Food Pantry in LaSalle has temporarily closed as a precaution during the COVID-19 pandemic. Aired 10/26 at 6:00am, 10:00am, and 12:00pm.

Program: Treatment. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that U.S. health officials have allowed emergency use of the first antibody drug to help the immune system fight COVID-19. Aired 11/10 at 6:00am and 10:00am.

Program: Poll Workers. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that poll workers in some states who came in contact with voters on Election Day are reporting they have tested positive for the coronavirus. Aired 11/16 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Long Lines. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that more people are waiting in long lines to get tested for the coronavirus, as cases surge nationwide and families hope to gather safely for the holidays. Aired 11/20 at 6:00am, 7:30am, and 10:00am.

Program: Vaccine. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that AstraZeneca says late stage trials of its COVID-19 vaccine developed with Oxford University were “highly effective” in preventing disease. Aired 11/23 at 6:00am, 10:00am, and 12:00pm. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that states are drafting plans for who gets the first doses of the COVID-19 vaccine when it becomes available this month, as the nation’s death toll from the pandemic surpassed three thousand one hundred in a single day for the first time. Aired 12/4 at 6:00am and 8:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Pfizer’s COVID-19 vaccine faces one final hurdle before an expected decision to green light the shot for use in millions of Americans. Aired 12/10 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Veterans’ Home. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that State officials have launched investigations into a coronavirus outbreak at the LaSalle Veterans’ Home that has infected nearly two hundred residents and staff members, and killed twenty-seven veterans. Aired 11/25 at 6:00am, 8:00am, 10:00am, and 12:00pm.

Program: Personal Attorney. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that President Trump says his personal attorney Rudy Giuliani has tested positive for coronavirus. Aired 12/7 at 6:00am.

Program: Food Banks. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that as the year of the pandemic nears an end, millions of Americans facing economic collapse are depending on food banks to stave off hunger. Aired 12/8 at 6:00am.

**Issue: Daylight Savings**

*We feel it is important for people to be reminded of the time change and to remember to change their smoke detectors.*

Program: Time Change. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that the American Red Cross is reminding residents nationwide that with the time change set for this weekend, everyone should take the opportunity to test their smoke detectors. Aired 10/28 at 7:00am.

**Issue: Drug Abuse**

*Drug Abuse is becoming a scourge of society, with opium overdose, costing the nation, just economically, nearly 80 billion a year.*

Program: Drug Charges. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that a Spring Valley man is facing drug charges after an investigation by the Tri-County Drug Enforcement Narcotics Team. Aired 10/14 at 7:00am.

Program: LSD. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that an Oglesby man who was being held in the LaSalle County Jail on an unrelated matter was charged with a class 2 felony for unlawful delivery of LSD. Aired 10/14 at 8:00am.

**Issue: Economy**

*“it’s the Economy, Stupid” – quote from Bill Clinton’s Presidential Campaign, 1992. Without a strong economy, nothing else matters.*

Program: Coronavirus. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that global shares and U.S. stock futures have fallen after President Trump said he and first lady Melania Trump tested positive for the new coronavirus. Aired 10/2 at 6:30am and 12:00pm.

Program: Brother’s Country Supply. Broadcast two two hour live events at Brother’s Country Supply in Ottawa informing listeners about the Christmas sale and encouraging listeners to take advantage of the sale. Aired 11/28 from 10:00am until 12:00pm and 12/19 from 10:00am until 12:00pm.

**Issue: Education**

*An Investment in Knowledge Pays The Best Interest – Benjamin Franklin*

Program: Imagination Library. Broadcast a two minute message informing listeners about Imagination Library from LaSalle County United Way on National Young Readers Day. Aired 11/10 at 7:40am.

Program: Little Free Library. Broadcast a two minute message informing listeners about the Little Free Libraries in Princeton, Peru, and Mendota on Young Reader's Day. Aired 11/10 at 8:10am.

### **Issue: Emergency Alert System**

*As a participating station in the EAS system, we receive and send tests and warnings.*

Program: EAS tests. Sent the required monthly and weekly tests. Also, sent a Severe Thunderstorm Warning on 11/10 at 2:41pm, 2:48pm, 3:20pm, 3:26pm, 3:29pm, 3:49pm, 3:58pm, 4:08pm, and 4:34pm. Sent a Tornado Warning on 11/10 at 3:38pm, 3:45pm, and 4:19pm. See Appendix A for broadcast times.

### **Issue: Employment**

*The current job market can be difficult to get into so knowing the fluctuations and changes regarding employment procedures can be an immense benefit.*

Program: Solid Pace. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that U.S. businesses kept hiring at a solid pace in October, defying fears of another slowdown. Aired 11/9 at 6:00am and 10:00am.

Program: Job Openings. Broadcast two hundred and seventy-nine thirty second PSAs informing listeners about job openings. See Appendix E for broadcast times.

### **Issue: Government**

*Government is important in society to prevent anarchy and it is beneficial to the population to be informed on what the government is doing.*

Program: Fund the Government. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Senate has sent President Donald Trump legislation to temporarily fund the government. Aired 10/1 at 6:00am.

Program: Vice President. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Vice President Mike Pence and his Democratic challenger, California Senator Kamala Harris, are poised to meet for a debate that will offer starkly different visions for the country. Aired 10/7 at 7:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the vice presidential debate has sharp moments, some modest interruptions, and violations of the debate clock. Aired 10/8 at 7:00am, 8:00am, and 12:00pm.

Program: Supreme Court Nominee. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that confirmation hearings for Supreme Court nominee Amy Coney Barrett are set to begin. Aired 10/12 at 6:00am and 10:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Supreme Court nominee Amy Coney Barrett is set to face senator's questions during a second day of confirmation hearings. Aired 10/13 at 6:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message

informing listeners that the Senate is on track to confirm Judge Amy Coney Barrett to the Supreme Court. Aired 10/20 at 6:00am and 7:30am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Republican-led Senate has voted to advance Supreme Court nominee Amy Coney Barrett toward final confirmation despite Democratic objections. Aired 10/26 at 6:00am and 8:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that forty-eight year old Amy Coney Barrett is headed to the Supreme Court. Aired 10/27 at 6:00am, 7:30am, and 10:00am.

Program: Presidential Debate. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Donald Trump and challenger Vice President Joe Biden will compete for TV audiences in dueling town halls instead of meeting face-to-face for their second debate. Aired 10/15 at 6:00am and 8:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Donald Trump and Democrat Joe Biden squared off their scuttled second debate replaced by dueling televised town halls. Aired 10/16 at 6:00am, 7:00am, 8:00am, and 12:00pm. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Trump and Democratic Challenger Joe Biden are set to square off in their final debate. Aired 10/22 at 7:00am and 12:00pm. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Trump and Democratic Challenger Joe Biden scrapped over how to tame the raging coronavirus in their final 2020 debate. Aired 10/23 at 6:00am, 8:00am, and 12:00pm.

Program: Election. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Election day is today statewide and the polls will stay open through 7:00pm. Aired 11/3 at 6:00am and 10:00am. Broadcast several messages updating listeners about election results. Aired 11/3 for one minute and thirty seconds regarding information on the state races, including national news about the electoral vote count and Illinois being called for Biden at 8:02pm, for one minute and thirty seconds regarding updates on the local elections at 8:35pm, for one minute and thirty seconds regarding updates on the national election at 9:02pm, for one minute and thirty seconds regarding informing on the state races, including national news about the electoral vote count and Illinois being called for Biden at 9:35pm, for one minute and thirty seconds regarding updates on the local elections at 10:02pm, for one minute and thirty seconds regarding the State's Attorney call and the State Senate call at 10:35pm, for one minute and thirty seconds regarding updates on all the races still too close to call at 11:02pm, and for one minute and thirty seconds regarding a listing of all state and local elections that are final in the listening area at 11:35pm. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that there's a good chance that Americans won't know the winner of the 2020 presidential election until well into Wednesday. Aired 11/4 at 7:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Joe Biden stands on the brink of winning the presidency, needing to clinch just one more battleground state to defeat President Trump. Aired 11/5 at 7:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Joe Biden is now leading President Trump in the battleground state of Georgia. Aired 11/6 at 6:00am and 10:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the federal government has recognized President-elect Joe Biden as the "apparent winner" of the Nov. 3rd election. Aired 11/24 at 6:00am, 7:00am, and 8:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that two battleground states, Wisconsin and Arizona, certified their presidential election tallies Monday in favor of President-elect Joe Biden, even as President Trump's legal team continues to dispute the results. Aired 12/1 at 6:00am and 8:00am. Broadcast a thirty second

message informing listeners that presidential electors are meeting across the United States today to formally choose Joe Biden as the nation's next president. Aired 12/11 at 6:00am and 10:00am.

Program: Legal Challenge. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell says there's no reason for alarm as President Trump pursues legal challenges to the election. Aired 11/11 at 6:00am.

Program: Illinois Supreme Court. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that an Ottawa Judge has been selected to take a seat with the Illinois Supreme Court. Aired 11/12 at 6:00am and 12:00pm.

Program: Deficits. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the U.S. is starting the 2021 budget year the way the old year ended, with soaring deficits. Aired 11/13 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Hand Tally. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a hand tally of the presidential race in Georgia has turned up just over two thousand five hundred votes in one county that weren't previously counted. Aired 11/17 at 6:00am.

Program: Election Security Official. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that President Trump has fired the nation's top election security official, a widely respected member of the administration who had refuted the president's claims of electoral fraud. Aired 11/18 at 6:00am.

Program: Voter Fraud. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Attorney General William Barr said that the Justice Department has not uncovered evidence of widespread voter fraud and has seen nothing that would change the outcome of the 2020 presidential election. Aired 12/2 at 7:00am. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that Attorney General William Barr is departing amid lingering tension over the president's claims of election fraud and the investigation into President-elect Joe Biden's son. Aired 12/15 at 6:00am and 10:00am.

Program: Electoral Certification. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Supreme Court has rejected Republicans' last-gasp bid to reverse Pennsylvania's certification of President-elect Joe Biden's victory in the electoral battleground. Aired 12/9 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

### **Issue: Health/Wellness**

*This station recognizes that health is an important component in today's society. More and more listeners are taking up healthy lifestyles. Of course, there are always health scares and concerns to cover as well.*

Program: Flu Shot. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the LaSalle County Health Department will be holding a high dose flu shot clinic on Tuesday for those sixty-five years or older. Aired 10/5 at 7:00am and 12:00am.

Program: Blood Donations. Broadcast a fifteen second message informing listeners that as the United States braces for flu season, everyone is encouraged to donate blood if possible. Aired 10/28 at 8:00am and 12:00pm and 11/2 at 8:00am.

Program: Type 2 Diabetes. Broadcast ninety-three one minute PSAs informing listeners about the dangers of Type 2 Diabetes and informing listeners how to best prevent it. See Appendix B for broadcast times.

Program: Flu Vaccination. Broadcast ninety-six thirty second PSAs informing listeners about the importance of getting the flu vaccination. See Appendix C for broadcast times.

**Issue: Tourism**

*Tourism is very important to the area for tourists coming in, as Starved Rock State Park is renowned as the “Crown Jewel” of the Illinois State Park System, and draws many tourists on the weekends. And tourism from the area is important to our listeners because as Mark Twain once said, “Travel is fatal to prejudice, bigotry, and narrow-mindedness.”*

Program: Derecho. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the Derecho that struck North Central Illinois caused plenty of damage back in August, and one of the attractions hardest hit was Matthiessen State Park. Aired 10/9 at 6:00am and 8:00am.

Program: Reopened. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announced Thursday that construction is complete at the Starved Rock Lock and Dam and the Illinois River is now reopened to navigation. Aired 10/30 at 7:00am, 10:00am, and 12:00pm.

**Issue: Traffic and Safety**

*Updating listeners on traffic, trouble spots, and hazardous driving is an important function of our station*

Program: Furlough. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that American Airlines and United Airlines say they will furlough thirty-two thousand workers between them because negotiations in Washington have failed to produce more federal aid for the industry. Aired 10/1 at 7:00am and 10:00am.

Program: Motorcycle Crash. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a fatal motorcycle crash southeast of Seneca has killed one person. Aired 10/12 at 6:00am and 12:00pm.

Program: Roundabout. Broadcast a twenty second message informing listeners that bad weather has delayed the full opening of the new roundabout in Peru. Aired 10/27 at 6:00am and 10:00am.

Program: Gas Prices. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that local and statewide gas prices are near or just below the national average according to the American Automobile Association. Aired 12/22 at 6:00am and 9:00am.

**Issue: Unemployment**

*The area generally has a higher unemployment rate than the average for the state and nation. With the closing of many industries, such as the LTV steel plant in Hennepin, and Westclox in Peru, unemployment is always a hot topic.*

Program: Unemployment Numbers. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that the latest county unemployment numbers have been released by the state, and they show some counties have had the number of unemployed go up in the last month. Aired 12/24 at 6:00am, 7:00am, 9:00am, 10:00am, and 12:00pm.

**Issue: Winter Weather**

*This was a severe winter, and was very important with schools closed, infrastructure (power and water) disrupted, and roads very dangerous. Simple tasks became impossible with the many frequent snow storms that roared through the area.*

Program: Hurricane. Broadcast a thirty second message informing listeners that a hurricane warning has been issued for a stretch of the northern U.S. Gulf Coast as Hurricane Delta has begun its trek on a path forecast to take it toward Louisiana. Aired 10/8 at 6:00am.

Program: Wind. Broadcast a twenty-eight second message informing listeners about a wind advisory in effect. Aired 11/10 at 1:00pm.

Program: Tornado. Broadcast a twenty-five second message informing listeners about the tornado watch in effect. Aired 11/10 at 2:10pm.

Program: Winter Weather. Broadcast a twenty-five second message informing listeners of the winter weather advisory in effect. Aired 12/29 at 2:00pm and 7:00pm.
