FCC Q2 2021 write-up

In April 2021, we reported that the results of the 2020 census will cost Pennsylvania a seat in congress. Pennsylvania is one of seven states losing one spot in the house, with New York and Ohio also being on that list. The 2020 count showed Pennsylvania has a population of slightly more than 13 million, that's up 2.4 percent from 2010, but that number lags behind the national average

In May 2021, we reported business and event restrictions in Pennsylvania have been lifted. The only restriction left is a mask mandate for people who are not vaccinated. The current order requires masks for unvaccinated and partially-vaccinated people to stay in place until June 28th, or when 70% of Pa. is fully vaccinated -- whichever happens first.

In June 2021, we reported the statewide order requiring universal face coverings has officially been lifted. The Pennsylvania Department of Health made the announcement Friday after continued progress toward stopping the spread of COVID-19 throughout the commonwealth. The Acting Secretary of Health saying that despite the order, businesses, organizations, health care providers and other entities will maintain the option of requiring employees, guests or customers to wear a mask, regardless of their vaccination status.
