Univision News & Public Affairs Programming

Noticiero Univision is a daily evening news program. It provides a general rundown of the day's headlines. Story content on the program centers on news stories and issues of utmost importance to Hispanic and Latino Americans (with reports focusing on immigration and diplomatic relations with Latin America highlighted regularly, as well as issues relating to government, healthcare and economic issues)

Noticiero Univision Edicion Nocturna is the late night edition of this program.

Primer Impacto (*First Impact*) is a Spanish-language television news program broadcast by Univision on weekday afternoons as well as on the weekends. Primer Impacto focuses on news of the U.S. and the world, República Deportiva (Sports Republic), movies, weather, curiosities and the main story of the day.

Aquí y Ahora (*Here and Now*) is an American Spanish-language newsmagazine television program that is broadcast on the Univision television network in the United States on Sunday evenings.

Locally Produced News & Public Affairs Programming

"Noticiero Arkansas" is a 30-minute weekday newscast which is hosted by Andrea Guzman. It airs twice daily every Monday through Friday and addresses up to the minute local, national and international news stories and issues of the utmost importance to the local community of Hispanic and Latino Americans.

"Spotlight Latino" is a 30-minute Spanish language news magazine which is hosted by Rolando Ochoa and Rodolfo Portillo. It airs every weekend on Saturday and Sunday. Weekly topics vary but include interviews with local community leaders, reports on topics of public health and safety, matters concerning education in the local community, matters concerning changes to the nation's immigration laws & regulations as well as other local issues and events.

These are all produced locally to address current issues of local and community interest. The following are some of the stories which addressed these issues during this reporting period.

Noticias Arkansas:

July 19, 2023 New affordable housing coming to Springdale Andrea Delgado

Springdale will soon be home of new affordable housing units in its downtown area. More affordable housing to get to downtown Springdale...

A housing company is building new apartments in downtown Springdale, and a nonprofit is working to make some of them easier to afford. The project, named"Big Emma" by its planners, is a 77-unit mixed-income apartment development located on Emma avenue.

August 21, 2023 CAMP Scholarship

We interviewed a representative from Drury University in Farmington to talk about their Camp Scholarship, which provides financial aid to students who are migrants. We spoke about the benefits of the scholarship, the type of help and resources it provides, and how students can apply if they qualify.

September 6, 2023 EforAll: Pitch Contest Erik Gonzalez

EforAll NWA, a local nonprofit, came to our studio for an interview to talk about their pitch contest. This event provides the opportunity to entrepreneurs to pursue their dreams by allowing them to present their business idea in 2 minutes in front of judges who later vote for their favorite three ideas. The winners receive money ranging from \$500 - \$1500 to put it to use in their business idea.

Sept. 6, 2023 Preparing for the ACT Rolando Ochoa

In this story we spoke with a local organization that provides resources for Hispanic parents and their children in Little Rock to prepare them for college. We spoke with Mamas Unidas about their ACT preparation classes that they have started offering in order to better prepare the students as they get ready to take this important test.

September 15, 2023 A road to citizenship Andrea Delgado

Community organizers and local immigration lawyers invited the Hispanic community to attend a free naturalization event in Rogers, Arkansas on September 17th. Prior to the event, we spoke with two organizers (Edith Chavez de Oseguera, and Laura Ferner) about the clinic where they were able to talk about the services that were going to be provided in the event. Many people were able to benefit from this naturalization clinic because several lawyers provided their services for free.

Spotlight Latino:

August 18th, 2023 Back to School Tips Pablo Morales

With back to school starting, we spoke with Arkansas State Police to learn some tips while driving to and from school. We talked about school safety, driving and texting, and the officer also gave important information for students to stay safe in school during the school year.

August 2, 2023

Poisonous plants Rolando Ochoa

We spoke with Dr. Amanda Novack from Baptist Health to talk about the safety precautions we need to take during summer while hiking or outside in nature, especially with a specific plan called poison hemlock. Dr. Novack talked about the danger of this plant species and how to recognize it.

July 8, 2023 Visiting a homeless Shelter Pablo Morales

In this segment for Spotlight Latino, we visited 7Hills Homeless Shelter in Fayetteville. We were given a tour of the place which provides shelter to local homeless people in our region. We talked about the services they provide, and how people can benefit from their programs.

July 22, 2023 Cafecito + Charla Andrea Delgado

Cafecito and Charla is a program from the Springdale School district aimed to provide important information to parents who have kids attending this district. We interview Maribel Tapia, ESL communications specialist with SSD, to talk about her vision with this show, the information they provide, and how people can stay connected with them. Cafecito and Charla provides resources in Spanish for the community, and connects the parents with these resources and information so they can be aware about the things going on in the district.

September 30, 2023 Lucha Libre in Arkansas Zuzuki Monarez

In this segment, Zuzuki visited a local wrestling center to talk about Lucha Libre in our region. We were able to interview several of the wrestlers to talk about this unique sport. We also spoke with women that are part of the teams here locally to get the word out that this sport can also be done by women.
