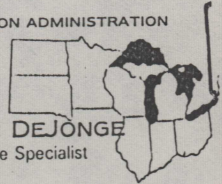

This acknowledges receipt of FAA Form 7460-1, "Notice of Proposed Construction or Alteration," dated January 10, 1987, which requested an aeronautical study to determine the feasibility of deleting obstruction lighting on three towers.

Structure: 3 Antenna Towers

We have conducted an aeronautical study of this structure under the authority of Sections 307(a) and 313(a) of the Federal Aviation Act of 1958, as amended. Study disclosed the towers do not exceed FAA obstruction standards.


Therefore, we would have no objection to your proposal to delete obstruction marking and lighting for the three towers.
