1. Economy

"Despite a slowdown in GDP growth in the third quarter of 2021, along with rising concerns around inflation and the new omicron coronavirus variant, we think the U.S. economic recovery is far from finished. U.S. real GDP increased just 2% annualized in the third quarter of 2021, the slowest rate so far in the economic recovery. An abrupt drop in consumer goods spending, especially vehicles, which have been subject to severely reduced supply, drove this slowdown. The rebound in consumer services also slowed because of the rise in coronavirus cases caused by the delta variant." - Preston Caldwell
