This is in response to your EEO audit letter dated October 30, 2023, regarding the EEO program for the subject Station licensed to ION Television License, LLC ("Licensee").


The Station employs fewer than five full-time employees. The Station's full-time employees, identified only by job title, and the number of hours regularly assigned to work per week are:

Manager, Station Broadcasting	40 hours/wk.
Station Engineer	40 hours/wk.

In response to your Question 2(b)(vi), there are no pending or resolved complaints involving the Station filed during the Station's current license term before any governing body having competent jurisdiction under federal, state, territorial, or local law, alleging unlawful discrimination in the employment practices of the Station based on race, color, religion, national origin or sex. Finally, the Licensee is not the broker of another station within its market and WPXL-TV is not a brokered station.
