Issues addressed: **News and weather information**

In addition to producing and providing five weekday local/regional news segments, daily national news was provided by the Salem Radio Network and local/regional weather updates provided twice hourly each day.

Severe weather coverage was needed this quarter with approximately twenty eight hours of hourly continuous coverage.

Issue addressed: **Kansas Winter Wheat and Harvest**


