

**The following statement was aired on November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 at 7:56am CT as part of the Pre-Filing Announcement requirement:**

On March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2004, WVUA-FM was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until Apr 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. Our license will expire on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. We must file an application for license renewal with the FCC on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011. When filed, a copy of this application will be available for inspection during regular business hours. It contains information concerning the station's performance over the last 8 years.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application, and to whether this station has operated in the public interest, should file comments and petitions with the FCC by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012.
