Under the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, the licensee of KLIR, Three Eagles Communications, Inc., is required to place in its public inspection file a list of what the licensee considered to have been some of the significant problems, needs, and issues of the service area during the last quarter, and some of the programs the station aired to help meet those problems and needs. During the quarter just ending, the licensee of KLIR made a concerted effort to ascertain the problems, needs, and issues perceived by the people in the service area. This process included personal interviews with leaders and citizens in the service area. In the pages that follow, the licensee lists and describes the representative programming elements that have been aired on KLIR designed to deal with the ascertained problems and needs in the community.

Quarterly Issues/Programs addressed in News Programming April, May, June 2013

KLIR is committed to serving all elements of this community; **KLIR** continues to cover issues of significance in newscasts aired on a daily basis. During this quarter, **KLIR** provided service to the community through daily news coverage reflected in the current on-going schedule:

Monday through Friday, 6am, 6:30am, 7am, 7:30am, 8am, 8:30am, 12pm, 4pm, 5pm and 6pm. On Saturday at 6am, 6:30am, 7am, 7:30am, 8am, and 12pm.

A six minute interview with Nebraska Governor Dave Heineman dealing with current local and state issues runs bi-weekly at 6:30 Saturday mornings.

KLIR is also a CNN affiliate, airing national/international newscasts around the clock seven days a week airing national and international newscasts and financial minutes.

Breaking News of immediate nature is also incorporated into programming as need occurs.

In addition to regular significant coverage of issues in daily newscast, during this period the station also expanded its focus to better serve the community. Weekly news features were added to devote more attention and analysis to issues affecting residents across the region. These weekly series aired daily, with 5 minutes of coverage Monday though Friday between 6am and 6pm and 2 minutes of coverage Saturday between 6am and 10am.

FIVE ISSUES FOR THE FCC - 2nd Quarter

- 4-1 thru 6-5 We provided coverage of the conclusion of the Nebraska legislative session for this year. Our station informed listeners of upcoming votes and measures that were passed, measure that failed, and those not even voted upon. Our News Department interviewed State Senators to provide insight into how the legislative process works, including the meaning and use of the filibuster, and how the new laws will affect our listeners.
- 4-15 thru 6-7 Our station dug into depth on the status of the Medicaid expansion bill and what will happen after not being voted on during the legislative session. Information was provided through interviews with State Senators close to the bill along with local and state medical experts who advised our listeners about procedures that are followed and who will be affected if Medicaid is not expanded in Nebraska. We provided interviews from parties both in favor and against the bill.

4-11 thru 6-29 – 2013 marks the 100 anniversary of the Lincoln Highway which dissects our listening area. We discussed the history of the Lincoln Highway and its impact on area cities and towns. Local officials offered their thoughts to 100 year anniversary of the highway and talked about events that would take place in celebrating this historic event. We also discussed the importance of the highway for the livelihood of our community.

4-24 thru 5-2 – We dug into a controversial proposed business development in Butler County. We informed listeners of the possible construction of a hog confinement facility in the vicinity of Brandenburgh Lakes. Residents of the community were opposed to the construction. We allowed local residents to comment on the project, including how it would impact their homes and property values in the area. We also provided time for those in favor of the construction to voice their opinions on why the construction was important.

5-15 thru 6-29 – We continued to inform listeners about the different cancer awareness related events that were going on in the area. We conducted several interviews with organizers for the Boxer 500-relay in David City, Team Jack for pediatric cancer awareness, Rollin' to Colon bike ride for colon cancer awareness, and Relay for Life in Platte County. We offered tips on cancer awareness, preparedness, and why regular check ups are so important.


