Date: January 5, 2019 **Time of Day:** 6:090 pm **Duration:** 2-3 minutes

Brief description of program (format, participants, contents, etc.):

The on air personality announced several American Red Cross Blood Drives around the area during the month of January. It was mentioned that blood donors are always needed to help those around us.

Issue: Healing from the Hurt of Abuse

We ran the following program to address it: Revive Our Hearts

Date: January 24 & 25, 2019 **Time of Day:** 11:30 am **Duration:** 25 minutes

Brief description of program (format, participants, contents, etc.):

Paulina Torres joined the program hosted by Nancy DeMoss Wolgemuth to discuss and share the abuse she suffered as a child at the hands of her mom’s boyfriends. The “me too” movement has shown how much widespread pain there is in the aftermath of abuse. Paulina shared how she has found healing and encouraged others in the process.

Issue: Dads Helping Daughters Become Confident Women

We ran the following program to address it: Focus on the Family

Date: February 11-12, 2019 **Time of Day:** 10:30 am **Duration:** 25 minutes

Brief description of program (format, participants, contents, etc.):

Dr. Meg Meeker joined the program and shared about the special bond with her own father and how it helped to shape her life. She addressed the negative influences on young women in the culture from peer pressure to social media and how a dad can make a difference.

Issue: Severe Weather and Road Closings

We ran the following program to address it: Live on air breaks

Brief description of program (format, participants, contents, etc.):

The winter storm produced heavy snow and blowing snow causing road closures across the listening area. On air staff provided updates on the storm and its impact, along with road closings.

Issue: Bullying

We ran the following program to address it: Family Life Today

Date: March 7-8, 2019 **Time of Day:** 12:30 pm **Duration:** 25 min.

Brief description of program (format, participants, contents, etc.):

Author Jonathan McKee shared with the program hosts and listeners how he was bullied throughout his school years and gave wise advice on how to handle the bullies in your child's life. He reminded us that every child is either the bully, bullied, or a bystander.

Issue: Preparing for the Storm Season

We ran the following program to address it: On Air Breaks

Date: March 15, 2019 **Time of Day:** 8:00 am hour **Duration:** 2-3 minutes break (5 breaks)

Brief description of program (format, participants, contents, etc.):

The on air personality interviewed the National Weather Service in Goodland. They discussed what to expect this spring. (They are predicting a bad storm season.) They discussed the difference between a watch and a warning, what to do if there is a severe weather warning and tornado warning. Spotter training classes were mentioned.
