**Date:** October 23-25, 2019    **Time of Day:** 4:30am & 3pm    **Duration:** 25 minutes

Guest, Sheri Keffer, joined the program to discuss the wounds of sexual betrayal of her first husband. The “red flags” were discussed along with how to repair, rebuild and recover from post-traumatic stress.
